Personnel

We are currently doing backgrounds on one applicant for the open Police Officer position. We had two interested parties inquire about the SRO position, but they have not submitted personal history statements at this time. We reached out to both individuals but have not heard back from them.

Public Safety

On November 27th, Officer Ethan Bishop and Officer Kris Greenhill were dispatched to the 600 block of US HWY 281(TXDOT Office) in reference to an auto- pedestrian accident. Upon their arrival they found a male subject down in the roadway. They later determined through witness's that two males were seen crossing HWY 281 at 281 Loop and one male did not make it across the street and was struck by a Ford F-250 pickup. The driver of that vehicle remained on scene and is cooperating with the investigation. The victim who was positively identified died on scene. The police department will be continuing this investigation with the assistance of the Texas Department of Public Safety. We are currently awaiting autopsy results and blood analysis from the deceased victim. At this time no charges have been file in this case.
