1. Call to order.

Councilmember Coleman called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. Councilmember Babb led the invocation.

OPEN SESSION:

2. Citizens to be heard.

Citizen Adelle Moreland spoke about the recurring road blokes at South Ave G and Hwy 290, specifically how it hinders access to the post office which is a 24/7 public access building. She also spoke about concerns with the poor lighting at that intersection and how the blockade is not illuminated.

ITEMS FOR INDIVIDUAL CONSIDERATION:

3. Discussion of and action on the City of Johnson City Quarterly Investment Report for quarter ending December 31, 2022. (Staff)

Councilmember Dildine made the motion to approve the item. Councilmember Guthrie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the item was approved.

4. Discussion of and action on a request for a variance from Municipal Code of Ordinances Chapter 3 Building Regulations, Article 3.06 Signs, Section 3.06.004 Definitions and Specific Restrictions by Old Annex Office Solutions, LLC for four (4) sidewalk signs to be located at or near 200 N. Ave. G, Johnson City, Texas 78636, property more particularly described as BCAD Prop. ID No. 84703. (Applicant)

Councilmember Babb made the motion to approve the 4 sidewalk signs for a period of 12 months. Councilmember Fisher seconded the motion. All were in favor and the item was approved.

5. Discussion of and action on a First Amendment to Agreements for Software License and Service and Access and Use of Software between the City of Johnson City, Texas, CentralSquare Technologies, LLC, and Blanco County for public safety software programs and related services for the Johnson City Police Department. (CentralSquare)

Councilmember Babb made the motion to approve the item. Councilmember Dildine seconded the motion. All were in favor and the item was approved.

6. Discussion of and action on an Amendment to a Real Estate Donation Agreement for the donation of a portion of a Municipal street, i.e. Avenue D (otherwise known as N. LBJ Dr.), to the Johnson City Independent School District. (JCISD)

Councilmember Fisher made the motion to approve the item as presented. Councilmember Guthrie seconded the motion. All were in favor and the item was approved.

Council adjourned into closed session at 6:21 pm.

The chair directed staff to renegotiate a sales tax sharing agreement with ESD 1 for newly annexed areas.
