A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY, TEXAS NOMINATING CANDIDATES FOR THE BLANCO COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR THE 2024-2025 TERM; AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY STEPS TO IMPLEMENT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS RESOLUTION; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ADOPTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the terms of the current Blanco County Appraisal District (the "District") Board of Directors expire on December 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, each taxing unit may nominate up to five (5) candidates for the 2024-2025 term.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

Section One. Nomination. The City Council of the City of Johnson City, Texas nominates the following individuals for the Blanco County Appraisal District Board of Directors 2024-2025 term:

Section Two. Authorization. The Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to take all necessary steps to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section Three. Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section Four. Recitals. The City Council finds all of the above recitals to be true and correct and incorporates the same in this Resolution as findings of fact.

Section Five. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of this Resolution. The City

Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution, and each section, subsection, clause, or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared void.

RE: Blanco County Appraisal District Board of Director's Nominations for the 2024-2025 Term

Dear Mayor Fisher;

The terms of the current Directors of the Blanco County Appraisal District will expire on December 31, 2023. Directors are elected to two-year terms by the governing bodies of voting taxing units within the appraisal district. The Blanco County CAD Board of Directors has five elected positions; it is your taxing unit's duty to nominate members that you feel will represent your taxing unit, the district, and the taxpayers within the Blanco County CAD. Existing board members can serve again, but they must be renominated and reelected.

This process starts with the chief appraiser calculating the number of votes that a taxing unit receives. Each taxing unit's number of votes equals its percentage of overall 2022 tax levy in Blanco County multiplied by 5,000.

The chief appraiser then notifies the taxing units of the number of votes it may cast. The following is a list of all voting taxing units and their number of votes.

Each voting taxing unit can nominate, by resolution, one candidate for each of the positions to be filled (up to five nominees per taxing unit). Your nominee resolution must be submitted to the Blanco County Appraisal District by October 15, 2023.

The chief appraiser then prepares a ballot of nominees and submits it to the taxing units by October 30, 2023.

Each voting taxing unit casts their allotted votes to one candidate or splits their votes among multiple candidates by written resolution. Taxing units must return voting results to Blanco CAD by December 15, 2023. The chief appraiser will then notify the taxing units of the outcome.



I have taken the liberty to ask if the current board members are willing to serve another term. All members have indicated they are willing to serve another term.

Board members qualifications include being a resident of the district, residing in the district for a minimum of the prior two years, not being an employee of a taxing unit within the district, and not owing delinquent property taxes. An elected official of a taxing unit is eligible to be a board member.
