City of Johnson City Appoints Officer Chad Wiggins as Interim Chief of Police

Following Chief of Police Ross Allen's resignation from the City of Johnson City Police Department, the City has appointed Officer Chad Wiggins as Interim Chief of Police effective February 23, 2024 at 5 p.m. Chief Allen recently accepted employment with the Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA) law enforcement agency.

Interim Chief of Police Chad Wiggins will serve in this temporary role for an undetermined period of time while the City receives and reviews applications for a permanent replacement. The City has posted the Chief of Police position on the City's website for internal and external applicants, and the first review of applicant submittals will occur on or about Friday, March 8, 2024.

"I have been with this Department for many years," writes Officer Wiggins, and "I have continued to train new officers and work towards a more efficient patrol. The roles of patrol and Interim Chief are different in comparison, but...I am willing to learn everything needed to lead this Department forward."

The City of Johnson City thanks Interim Chief Chad Wiggins for his service to the community, and we look forward to working with him during this transition.
