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CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING January 23, 2023

The Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the *Charter Township of Kalamazoo* was held on <u>Monday, January 23, 2023,</u> at <u>7:30 p.m.</u> in the Board Room of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo Administration Building, 1720 Riverview Drive, Kalamazoo. MI 49004.

Item 1 CALL TO ORDER

Clerk Miller called the meeting to order at 7:30 pm. He moved to appoint Trustee Leuty as Chair pro tem, seconded by Treasurer Miller. Voice vote, Motion carried.

Item 2 PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Clerk Miller led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Item 3 ROLL CALL OF BOARD MEMBERS.

Trustee Moaiery moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to excuse Trustee Robinson and Supervisor Martin. Voice vote, Motion carried.

<u>Item 4</u> <u>ADDITIONS AND DELETIONS TO AGENDA</u>

Trustee Leuty withdrew Item 9G, which was submitted by him and Treasurer Miller.

<u>Item 5</u> <u>PUBLIC COMMENT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS</u>

Joey Bird, 837 Edison, said it was wrong for Board members to address Township issues on social media. He is working with others to recall several Board members.

Mikey Rogers addressed social media post by Trustee Glass. Fired fire chiefs just did their job. It has been four months and we have not brought the chiefs back.

Angie Ponzini, 2031 Skyline, wants us to move forward and unite the township and restructure, with no unnecessary money spent. The time is now.

Item 9 NEW BUSINESS

Item 9A REQUEST TO APPROVE THE AMENDMENT OF KALSEC PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT

Trustee Leuty addressed the changes to the Kalsec PUD. Planning Commission approved expanded building and a sidewalk along W Main. PUD changes require Board approval as well.

Trustee Leuty moved, seconded by Trustee Moaiery, to approve the amendment of the Kalsec PUD.

Clerk Miller asked about the sidewalk. Trustee Leuty replied that the 5-foot sidewalk has been previously required and is being completed over time.

Treasurer Miller asked if there are any additional jobs. Ty Weiss from Kalsec addressed the Board meeting, there are a few new jobs to support a new process.

Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9B REQUEST TO APPROVE THE POLICE CADET COMPENSATION

Chief Ergang spoke to the proposal, which has been approved by the Policy Administration Committee to increase from \$12 an hour to \$14.50, then \$15 an hour. Cadets if successful go on to the Police Academy.

Trustee Moaiery moved, seconded by Trustee Glass, to approve the increase approved by the PAC to increase cadet compensation to \$14.50 per hour for the first six months of employment and \$15 per hour thereafter. Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9C REQUEST TO APPROVE THE POLICE CANDIDATE COMPENSATION

Chief Ergang spoke to compensation for candidates at the Academy, raising from \$15 to \$20 per hour. An MCOLES grant will pay in the short run.

Clerk Miller moved, seconded by Treasurer Miller, to approve the police cadet compensation. Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9D REQUEST TO APPROVE THE EVIDENCE AND PROPERTY ROOM SHELVING/STORAGE

Chief Ergang spoke to the storage proposal -- \$12,433.14 project is coming along, although it has been delayed. The money is available in Police Capital.

Trustee Leuty moved, seconded by Trustee Moaiery, to approve the purchase. Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9E RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE KATS SERVICES AGREEMENT

Manager Mitchell spoke to the fiscal year question, it needs to be in by February. Our portion is \$2000. Many local governments are participating.

Treasurer Miller moved, seconded by Trustee Leuty, to approve the policy and make the payment. Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9F RESOLUTION TO APPROVE THE RCKC 2023 PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE PROJECTS FOR 2023

Manager Mitchell spoke to the PASER ratings (currently 4 to 7) and will be moved to 8 by this work. Carryover from last year of \$133,562, gives a total of \$432,248 available for projects in the current year. Trustee Leuty asked whether this included matching funds, and yes it does.

Treasurer Miller moved, seconded by Clerk Miller, to approve receipt. Roll call vote, (5-0), Motion carried.

Item 9G REQUEST TO APPROVE THE NEXT STEPS CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN MANAGER AND BOARD

Item 11 BOARD MEMBER REPORTS

Trustee Glass thanked Acting Chief Weidemann. Her qualms are on the two chiefs, not the firefighters. She blames Supervisor Martin for not acting on recruitment. Do we condone the hostile work environment? Why are we considering building a new fire station in the face of more pressing needs? Why have we failed to post the necessary positions? Some Board members are not transparent.

Trustee Moaiery said this week is the 36th anniversary of the Challenger shuttle disaster. When people question how that happened, "groupthink" has been highlighted. Nobody tried to be stupid or lazy or evil, but the O-ring issue was known beforehand. A mode of thinking where it is hard to realistically appraise alternative courses of action. We need to respect and be kind to each other.

Clerk Miller distributed to the Board and read aloud his letter of resignation as Township Clerk, effective February 28. This is not connected to the difficulties the Township has been dealing with in recent months, or with any interpersonal issues. It is because of the long hours required in the weeks leading up to elections and working 24 hours straight on an election day.

Treasurer Miller expressed appreciation for Clerk Miller's service. She was discouraged by Trustee Glass' comments. She thanked the front office staff for outstanding service in collecting taxes. She is sorry it has taken so long to determine several issues.

Trustee Leuty shared that the Township gets its authority through the State and does not have a mandate to have a Manager. There is no standard outline for what a Manager does. Each township with a Manager has their own arrangement. He explained the Manager's scope of responsibility according to our policy documents. The SOGs and collective bargaining agreements make further policy standards. One of the risks is if documents are misinterpreted.

After more than four months since the firing of our chiefs, there has been no forward motion on staffing. Alternative options were available, such as placing employee on leave, or involving the department head. No harassment training has been held.

Item 12 ATTORNEY'S REPORT

We cannot make any contributions, but contributed services agreement is OK, you are already paying Township engineers to do this work.

On Feb. 2 home occupations public hearing before Planning Commission.

There was some discussion about the procedure for appointing a new clerk. We want to appoint within 45 days of the vacancy to avoid a special election for the position.

Item 13 MANAGER'S REPORT

On Jan. 10 Kalamazoo County dispatch lost connection to radio system. There was an incident at school, with a student setting fire to materials and assaulting staff. ZBA met to grant variances to Graphic Packaging. Trustees continue to meet with Manager to set goals. Business 131 update: RAISE grant, \$3 billion, \$25 million per project is available.

Item 14 PUBLIC COMMENT

Todd Kowalski, Kalamazoo Township, thanked Clerk Miller. He called for release of more information. It is tough to be an employee in Kalamazoo Township when rules are not followed. One of our appeals process is to the Board. The Board has not acted on the chiefs' appeals.

Elizabeth Kowalski said it was disappointing to be used as an example. Board members have used their reports to run down other Board members and employees. Bring the Chiefs back.

Connie Butler, Kalamazoo Township, responded to Trustee Glass statement about the Chiefs' unprofessionalism, she showed her own lack of respect.

Angie Ponzini thanked the Clerk, and asked if a Trustee could replace him. We have to work out the problems.

Travis, Kalamazoo Township, commented on unprofessional communication by Board members. He referred to the Dunning-Kreuger effect.

Ed Branigan, Kalamazoo Township, said Board members like bashing someone for sharing their opinion.

INTRODUCTION AND PURPOSE OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION

As required per the Michigan Planning Enabling Act (MPEA) Act 33 of 2008, as amended, the Planning Commission shall submit a report of its 2022 activities to the Kalamazoo Township Board.

"A planning commission shall make an annual written report to the legislative body concerning its operations and the status of planning activities, including recommendations regarding actions by the legislative body related to planning and development."

In addition to fulfilling this requirement, the Annual Report and Work Plan increases information-sharing between staff, boards, commissions, and the governing body and assists with these entities with anticipating, preparing, and budgeting for upcoming priorities.

Home Occupation Ordinance

Additionally, the Planning Commission worked for several months in 2022 on the review and update of the Township's Home Occupation Ordinance. Modeled after top recommendations for best practices from municipal attorneys in Michigan, the home occupation ordinance update includes:

- Categories of home occupations that vary in intensity with associated appropriate approval processes
- Clarifies ambiguities in the current ordinance language
- Offers flexibility to residents to operate businesses within the home
- Establishes a clear path from review, to approval, to enforcement

The public hearing for the proposed ordinance text is scheduled to occur in February 2023.


Master Plan Update

A large undertaking headed by the Planning Commission in 2022 included the Township Master Plan update. Although work on the master plan is still underway, the Plan is anticipated to be adopted in summer/fall 2023, once all State requirements are completed. The Planning Commission met several times, open to the public, in 2022 to workshop Master Plan content and led a public outreach campaign for a few months.

Sidewalks and Pedestrian Improvements

In 2022, the Township installed 41 ADA sidewalk ramps to correct orphaned corners where existing sidewalk stopped short of reaching a road. Further, as part of the site plan approval process, the Planning Commission supported the construction of approximately 0.16 miles of new sidewalks in the Township.





KALAMAZOO TOWNSHIP MASTER PLAN UPDATE

Perhaps the most substantial undertaking planned for 2023 is the update of the Township's Master Plan. The Master Plan is a policy guiding document that plays a significant role in shaping the future fabric of a community. Throughout 2022, the Planning Commission will be working alongside McKenna and other Township staff to develop Master Plan content. Some planned elements of the Master Plan will include:

- Existing conditions (e.g., demographics, existing land uses, road network, SWOT, etc.)
- Future land uses (e.g., planned residential densities, commercial corridors, industrial corridors, mixed-use areas, etc.)
- Future transportation (motorized and non-motorized)
- Zoning plan and zoning recommendations
- Action-oriented implementation plan

EVALUATING A CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY & RRC CERTIFICATION

Working in tandem with the Master Plan update, Kalamazoo Township Planning Commission and Township staff may evaluate the feasibility of developing a Corridor Improvement Authority. In general, the purpose of a Corridor Improvement Authority is to "correct and prevent deterioration in business districts, encourage historic preservation, promote economic growth" along specific corridor(s) in a community. In 2023, the foundation to create a Corridor Improvement Authority may commence, with the adoption of the Master Plan. Initial activities will include identifying members of the Authority, creating bylaws, responsibilities, meeting schedules, and other applicable logistics.

Further, the Planning Commission can initiate the evaluation of becoming Redevelopment Ready certified (RRC). RRC is an incentive program offered by the Michigan Economic Development Corporation (MEDC) that assists communities across Michigan become prime for redevelopment opportunities. This first step in this process is to update and adopt a master plan that is compliant with RRC standards. The Planning Commission is already working on this initial task.

JOINT MEETINGS

One priority for the Planning Commission in 2023 is to establish more consistent communication with other Township Boards and officials, when needed. Further, feedback and collaboration from other Township Boards and organizations may be pertinent for important Planning Commission initiatives. In 2023, the Planning Commission may take the lead on hosting a joint meeting with other applicable Township Boards and



Commissions to increase transparency and collaboration. Some of the subjects a joint meeting may discuss include:

- The 2023 Master Plan
- A Corridor Improvement Authority
- Township brownfields

 Climate Action Committee updates and ongoing projects

TABLE OF CONTENTS

Currently, the zoning ordinance, as advertised online, does not have a table of contents. As such, it becomes cumbersome for the public (and Township staff) to navigate through the Ordinance and find applicable provisions. One of the priorities for 2023 is to develop a clickable table of contents for the Ordinance (with links) to increase useability.

OTHER ORDINANCE UPDATES

Throughout 2023, the Planning Commission and Township staff will intermittently examine and update other parts of the Township Zoning Ordinance to increase user-friendliness and clarity – as possible. Some of the ordinance updates that are proposed for review in 2023 are:

- Updating the sign ordinance in response to Reed v. Gilbert rulings
- Updating the Township's requirements pertaining to fencing around marijuana businesses
- Updating the outdoor storage setback requirement for Industrial Districts
- Updating provisions within the administrative site plan review process
- Updating ordinance provisions relating to land use screening

To the Kalamazoo Charter Township Board of Trustees:

I have both enjoyed and appreciated the opportunity to serve the Township, both as Trustee and as Clerk, for the last 14 years and two months. However, it is time for me to retire from my position as Clerk. I intend my resignation to be effective on February 28, 2023. The reason for making my intentions known now is so that the Board can use the time to recruit and select a candidate to serve as your Clerk, and have that person in place for two months before the next election on May 2, so that they may get training in running an election and their other duties.

I want to assure the Board that the reasons I am retiring now have nothing to do with the difficulties the Township has been facing in recent months, or with any inter-personal issues. Indeed, I wish I could stay to help with the resolution of some outstanding issues, but the election calendar prevents that.

It is the stress of working for 24 hours straight on Election Day, after weeks of long hours leading up to it, that is my primary reason for leaving now. The job of election administration has become significantly more complex, more onerous, and more contentious, in just the six years that I have been in the Clerk's position. More and more complexity has been laid onto election administrators, both by regulations and by voter-approved initiatives. Some of these provisions add important rights to voters, but all of them increase the complexity and time required to handle all of the hundreds of steps we must carry out. It is time for me to hand this off to someone younger, or at least someone with more energy than I possess at this point in my life.

I will be here training our new Election Coordinator until Feb. 28, and then at the request of the new Clerk for as much and as long as desired following that. There are a 1000 details to pass along, and I want my successor to be set up for success.

In addition, I would like to stay on the Township Climate Committee, and have more time than I have had up to now to help Kalamazoo Township to do our part in confronting the climate crisis.

I close by thanking the voters of Kalamazoo Township for electing me to office four times. I have always tried my best to be worthy of your trust.

Step 4b: Narrative of Interpretation

In reviewing the Utilization Analysis Chart, representatives from the Charter Township of Kalamazoo made the following observations:

Given the small numbers of employees in job categories Officials/Administrators (1), Professionals (4), Technicians (0), Administrative Support (6), and Service/Maintenance (3), it is difficult to determine statistically significant levels of underutilization compared to the relevant community labor market. However, it appears there is a trend toward the underutilization of white females in both the Officials/Administrators and Professionals categories.

In all three protective services categories (sworn officials, sworn patrol officers, and non-sworn) there appears to be a trend toward the underutilization of white females compared to the relevant community labor statistics. The only statistically significant level of underutilization was the underutilization of white women in the non-sworn protective services category. This category includes police candidates, police cadets, police administrative and support staff, and all fire department staff. When breaking down this category further, 100% of our police candidates, police administrative staff, and police cadets are white women. Therefore, it can be inferred that the underutilization of white women is resulting from the other job functions comprising this category, including the fire department, police support staff (e.g., property & ordinance enforcement, task force admins), and crossing guards.

Step 5: Objectives and Steps

- 1. Identify any potential barriers in recruitment that may deter females from applying for entry-level positions within the police and fire departments.
 - a. Survey new female recruits to determine what led them to apply to the department and what parts of the process may deter other female candidates from applying.
 - b. Conduct exit interviews with all employees who leave the organization voluntarily to determine whether there are any identifiable barriers to retention efforts for the organization.
- 2. Recruit an applicant pool for Charter Township of Kalamazoo jobs that accurately reflects our community.
 - a. Distribute job postings to a variety of schools, places of worship, community groups, and other organizations throughout Kalamazoo County and the State of Michigan, in addition to posting on electronic job boards and the Township website.
 - b. Depict both male and female employees in police department recruitment campaigns.
- 3. Identify any potential barriers to promotion for females within our organization.
 - a. Using the information gleaned from step a., review promotional processes to determine whether any barriers exist for female employees to be promoted within the agency.
 - b. Conduct informal surveys of female officers who are eligible for promotion within the department but do not self-select for the process to determine the reasoning behind their decision.

Step 6: Internal Dissemination

- 1. Distribute a hard copy of the EEOP Utilization Report to the Township Manager, the Fire Chief, and the Chief of Police.
- 2. Send an e-mail memorandum to all employees to let them know that a copy of the EEOP Utilization Report is available on request.
- 3. Send a TexComm message to all fire department employees to let them know that a copy of the EEOP Utilization Report is available on request.

AMENDMENT TO KALAMAZOO CHARTER TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to amend the home occupation provisions of the Township Zoning Ordinance to provide a tiered approached based on type of occupation and perceived affects on the adjoining properties; to make certain home occupations a special land use; to provide standards for approval of home occupations, to establish the responsible party for approving home occupations, depending on the tier; to provide an effective date; and to repeal the existing subsection.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF KALAMAZOO

ORDAINS:

SECTION I AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE 2.00 "General Provisions"

Article 2.00 "General Provisions", Section 2.08 "Home Occupations and Home-Based Business" is hereby repealed and replaced with the following Section 2.08:

"2.08 Home Occupations

A. Applicability

The term "home occupation" means an occupation or profession carried on in the home by resident members of the household where such use is clearly incidental and secondary to the principal use of the dwelling as a residence.

B. General Requirements

All home occupations shall be subject to the applicable requirements of the zoning district in which they are located, in addition to the following requirements.

- 1. Any business activity must be clearly incidental to the use of the dwelling as a residence.
- 2. The exterior appearance of any structure shall not be altered due to the business activity nor to support a home occupation.

- 3. No business activity shall be conducted in such a manner so as to cause the premises to differ from a residential character, whether by the use of colors, materials, construction, lighting, signs (except as permitted in this Section), or the emission of sounds or vibrations. Further, the home occupation shall not involve the storage, use or sale of hazardous, flammable, toxic, or explosive substances, other than types, sizes, and amounts commonly found in dwellings for hobby or domestic purposes.
- 4. The delivery and pickup of goods and materials used and/or produced in the operation of a home occupation shall be limited to the customary activity of the United States Postal Service and/or alternative private package services common to residential property in the area.
- 5. No traffic shall be generated by such home occupation in greater volumes than would normally be expected on a road of its specific classification as determined by the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County. Any need for parking generated by the conduct of such home occupation shall be provided by an off-street area.
- 6. A home occupation may be subject to annual inspection by the Building Official, Township Zoning Administrator and/or Township Fire Marshal, and shall be subject to termination if found not to be in compliance with the Zoning Ordinance.
- 7. No outdoor display and/or storage of materials, goods, supplies, or equipment used in the home occupation shall be allowed on the premises in any zoning district.
- 8. Sign. One non-illuminated nameplate, not more than two (2) square feet in area, shall be allowed per residence to identify a home occupation. The permitted sign shall not be located in any road right-of-way and shall not obstruct the clear vision of drivers. No other sign shall be used on the premises to advertise a home occupation.
- 9. The total area within the principal dwelling devoted to home occupations shall not exceed one-quarter of the usable residential floor area of the dwelling unit.
- 10. One detached accessory building may be used by a Category C home occupation, provided that there is no external evidence of the business activity. Any accessory building used for a home occupation shall be in full compliance with the standards for accessory buildings, as provided in Section 2.03 of this Ordinance.
- 11. The levels of waste and scrap generated by the home occupation for transfer as part of the Township's residential trash collection and disposal services shall not exceed two (2) ninety-six (96) gallons per week, or exceed the maximum amount ordinarily expected for residential refuse pickup.

C. Activities Not Considered a Home Occupation

 Bed-and-breakfast inns, roadside stands, garage or yard sales, auto service or repair garages, restaurants and bars, or similar establishments and/or activities as determined by the Township Zoning Administrator or Planner shall not be permitted or considered a home occupation.

D. Home Occupation Regulatory Categories

All home occupations shall be classified and regulated in three categories and subject to the following standards, in addition to the general requirements listed in sub- section B, above.

1. Category A - No Nuisance Potential:

This category of home occupation recognizes it is customary for dwelling occupants to perform office and similar work as incidental to residential use of a dwelling unit. Category A is referred to as a "no impact" home occupation. No aspects of the home occupation shall be visible on the exterior of the residence and there shall be no significant impact on surrounding properties. Category A home occupations are automatically permitted without permit application, review, or approval.

- a. A Category A home occupation includes activities such as:
 - receiving or initiating electronic or other video communication
 - telephone calls, mail, or electronic mail
 - · preparing or maintaining business records
 - · word or data processing
- b. Examples of Category A home occupations include:
 - telecommuting/ telework
 - word processing
 - accounting
 - internet sales
 - novelist or book editor
 - tutor or instructor of music, crafts or fine arts, where some clients come to the dwelling at different times for individual instruction, and other professions protected under State law
 - other similar endeavors

c. Category A work includes work performed for an employer in another location (telecommuting or telework) as well as work by a person residing in the dwelling unit that engages in the same type of activity under their own business. No customers shall be permitted to come to the dwelling, unless protected under State law. Category A home occupations shall not take place in a detached garage or detached accessory structure.

2. Category B - Limited Nuisance Potential:

This category of home occupation is largely indistinguishable from customary residential use of a dwelling unit but with off-street parking space(s). These home occupations are authorized by issuance of a Zoning Permit by the Zoning Administrator once conformance with standards specified in this Section are achieved. They are permitted in any dwelling unit in any district that allows single-family and two-family dwellings by an owner of the property, or by a renter of the property with the owner's written consent.

- a. A Category B home occupation includes activities such as:
 - any Category A home occupation that meets Category B requirements for off-street parking
 - financial, marketing or other professional services to customers or clients
 - small item repair
 - small scale food preparation and craft making

Retail sales of products on the premises shall not be permitted.

- b. Examples of Category B home occupations include:
 - professionals like a lawyer, doctor, architect, or engineer
 - small item repair
 - sewist, artist or small crafts maker
 - other similar endeavors
- c. Category B home occupations shall not take place in a detached garage or detached accessory structure. No retail sales are permitted and not more than two (2) customers/clients/patients are permitted at any time for service trade and by appointment only, with a maximum of ten (10) customers/clients/patients per day; hours of operation shall be between 8 am and 8 pm. Should complaints regarding any Category B home occupation arise, the classification and status of the home occupation shall be subject to review and approval by the Kalamazoo Township Zoning Administrator or, at their discretion, the Kalamazoo Township Planning Commission.

3. Category C - Up to Moderate Nuisance Potential:

This category of home occupation allows residents of a single-family or two-family dwelling unit on any property zoned or used for residential purposes to conduct economic activities on their property at a scale greater than in a home occupation Category A or B, but significantly less than a full-scale commercial or industrial enterprise. Because of the greater potential for nuisance impacts, the Planning Commission shall approve the home occupation by means of a Special Land Use Permit (SLUP). Standards for Special Land Use review and approval are specified in Section 26.03.

- a. Category C includes all home occupation uses permitted in Categories A and B that desire the additional employee(s), accessory structures, parking of a special vehicle, or retail sales. Permitted activities include:
 - small scale creation and sale of products
 - repair of small appliances and bicycles
 - sales and distribution of some products created elsewhere
- b. Examples of Category C home occupations permitted by SLUP include:
 - making and retail sales of candles, toys, and t-shirts
 - small appliance and bicycle repairs
 - operation of network marketing businesses on behalf of a third party, without any sales events at the home
 - other similar endeavors

c. Category C home occupations may have up to two non-occupant employees, who park on up to two off-street parking spaces. The home occupation may take place in a detached garage or detached accessory structure. Retail sales are permitted and not more than three customers/clients/ patients may be present at any time, hours of operation are limited to between 8 AM to 8 PM, or as limited per special land use approval, such as by appointment only.

E. Off-Street Parking and Commercial Vehicle Parking

- 1. All vehicle parking required for conduct of the home occupation shall be off-street as specified below, and per all requirements as specified by the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County.
 - a. Category A: No off-street parking spaces are required.

- b. Category B: Up to 2 off-street parking spaces shall be required for customers/clients/patients.
- c. Category C: One off-street space per each non-occupant employee permitted and up to 3 off-street parking spaces shall be required for customers/clients/patients.

F. Permits and Administration

1. No permit shall be required for the operation of a Category A home occupation. A permit shall be required for the operations of a Category B and Category C home occupation in accordance with the standards of this Ordinance. The initial application for a home occupation shall be made on a form to be provided by the Township. The applicant shall submit a sketch plan, drawn to scale, showing property lines; building footprints,' sidewalks; driveways; off-street parking areas; and other salient features. Upon receipt of a completed application and sketch plan, the Township shall review the application for completeness and compliance with the Zoning Ordinance. A special land use permit application shall be provided by the Township for those seeking approval of a Category C home occupation. The special land use request shall be reviewed against criteria for granting special land use approval, as specified in Section 26.03.C. If a home occupation is found to be operating outside the standards of this Ordinance, the Township may require the business owner to file an application for a home occupation or cease operation of the home occupation.

G. Home Occupation Review

The review procedures, standards, and required information in this Section are intended to provide a consistent and uniform method of review of proposed home occupation applications, to ensure full compliance with the regulations and standards contained in this Ordinance and other applicable ordinances and laws, including the Michigan Building Code, as amended, and to prevent adverse impact on adjoining or nearby properties.

1. Standards for Home Occupation Review and Approval

The Township Zoning Administrator shall consider the following criteria for granting approval of a home occupation:

- a. Compatibility to adjacent properties and land uses.
- b. The amount of traffic generated by the home occupation. The anticipated traffic generated by a home occupation shall not exceed what is normally expected on roads categorized as a private road or local road, as defined and classified by the Road Commission of Kalamazoo County.
- c. Off-street parking needs and locations.
- d. Availability of public services, in that the proposed home occupation shall be adequately served by public utilities and that no excessive use of public utilities is anticipated.
- e. Compatibility of the natural environment. The proposed home occupation shall be compatible with the natural environment and conserve natural resources and energy.
- 2. In the event the Township Zoning Administrator is challenged by their interpretation of the above criteria, or that the Zoning Administrator seeks interpretation of any part of this Section, the Planning Commission shall have final determination."

SECTION II EFFECTIVE DATE AND REPEAL

This ordinance shall take effect eight days following proper publication of notice of its adoption in accordance with and subject to Michigan Public Act 110 of 2006. All parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
