Kalamazoo Public Schools has received a COPS office grant award to improve radio coverage at Kalamazoo Central High School (KCHS) and Loy Norrix High School. There is a \$32,000 matching requirement from the award recipients, and KPS has requested the Township of Kalamazoo contribute \$10,000. The BDAs are \$50,000 apiece, and the grant funds will be used to purchase two BDAs: one for KCHS and one for Loy Norrix.
