WHEREAS, on February 24, 2015, the voters of the Charter Township of Kalamazoo approved a road bond proposal to borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Nine Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$9,750,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds in one or more series, payable in not to exceed eleven (11) years from the date of issue of each series, for the purpose of paying the costs of acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping road improvements in the township, including necessary rights-of-way, sidewalks, proper drainage facilities and appurtenances and attachments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the General Obligation Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2015 were sold in June 2015 at an interest rate less than estimated at the time of the February 2015 election; and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was published in the Kalamazoo Gazette on Tuesday, August 22, 2023, and on Tuesday, August 29, 2023, and was mailed by first class mail on August 10, 2023, to each owner and/or occupant of property proposed to be benefitted by such collection, disposal and recycling and yard waste collection not previously covered by said project nor assessed therefore; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board believes it is in the public interest to proceed as follows,

### **NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** as follows:

- 1. That the Township Board hereby determines to continue the Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling plans and hazardous waste subsidy for Township residents utilized in 2023 with the addition of benefitted dwelling units not previously assessed and for three times a year bulk trash collection and disposal; two times a year; yard waste collection and composting; and bi-weekly recycling collection.
- 2. That the Township Board does hereby approve the total estimated costs of the collection, disposal and recycling and yard waste collection and hazardous waste subsidy for the 2024 calendar year in the amount of \$583,981.

- 3. - 4. That the Township Treasurer is hereby directed to collect the foregoing assessments in a separate column on the next regular tax statement of the Township to be mailed to Township taxpayers in December of 2023.
- 5. That in the event of any delinquency in payment of this special assessment, interest and penalties shall accrue thereon in the same manner and extent as is applicable to Township taxes.
- 6. That in the event the total amount of the aforesaid levy is insufficient to cover all costs of collection, disposal and recycling of solid waste and yard waste collection and hazardous waste subsidy received from benefitted dwelling units within the Township during 2024, the deficiency shall be paid from the general fund of the Township.
- 7. That in accordance with previous action of the Township Board on September 17, 1990, a similar public hearing on a proposed assessment roll for the "Kalamazoo Charter Township Solid Waste Collection, Disposal and Recycling District" shall be held on the second Monday in September of 2024 for use in 2025, preceded by the required published notice in the local newspaper circulated within the Township, and by first class mailed notice to any benefitted dwelling units not previously covered by said project and assessed for the costs thereof.

### Board of Trustees,

As you recall in our previous financial audit there was a comment outlining the need to file our Continuing Disclosure for our Road Bonds. In review of this note, it was discovered this filing has not occurred since the start of our bonds. This action was not brought before the Board when the Road Bonds were issued.

Bonds issued by state and local governments are subject to ongoing monitoring and reporting to maintain compliance with federal tax requirements specifically related to tax-exempt bonds.

We are required to file five years previous and each year going forward to secure compliancy with Securities and Exchange requirements. This filing can be handled through a Financial Advisor by contract.

There are two contracts on the Agenda for approval with Bendzinksi and Co., our Financial Advisors.

- 1. The first contract is to bring us up to date with filings for the past five years. This contract is for a one-time fee of \$3,500.
- 2. The second contract ensures that we remain current with yearly filings through 2027. The annual fee is \$1,000.

In both cases, staff time will be required to assist our advisors by providing the needed information to file with through the Electronic Municipal Market Access (EMMA) portal.

The Issuer agrees to provide or cause to be provided, in a timely manner, to the MSRB through EMMA, in an electronic format as prescribed by the MSRB, notice of a failure by the Issuer to provide the annual financial information with respect to the Issuer described in subsection (b) above on or prior to the dates set forth in subsection (b) above.
- (d) Occurrence of Events. The Issuer agrees to provide or cause to be provided to the MSRB through EMMA, in an electronic format as prescribed by the MSRB, in a timely manner not in excess of ten business days after the occurrence of the event, notice of the occurrence of any of the following events listed in (b)(5)(i)(C) of the Rule with respect to the Bonds:
  - (1) principal and interest payment delinquencies;
  - (2) non-payment related defaults, if material;
  - (3) unscheduled draws on debt service reserves reflecting financial difficulties;
  - (4) unscheduled draws on credit enhancements reflecting financial difficulties;
  - (5) substitution of credit or liquidity providers, or their failure to perform;
  - described adverse tax opinions, the issuance by the Internal Revenue Service of proposed or final determinations of taxability, Notices of Proposed Issue (IRS Form 5701-TEB) or other material notices or determinations with respect to the tax status of the Bonds, or other material events affecting the tax status of the Bonds;
  - (7) modifications to rights of holders of the Bonds, if material;
  - (8) bond calls, if material, and tender offers;
  - (9) defeasances;
  - (10) release, substitution, or sale of property securing repayment of the Bonds, if material;
  - (11) rating changes;
  - (12) bankruptcy, insolvency, receivership or similar event of the Issuer, which is considered to occur when any of the following occur: the appointment of a receiver, fiscal agent or similar officer for the Issuer in a proceeding under the U.S. Bankruptcy Code or in any other proceeding under state or federal law in which a court or governmental authority has assumed jurisdiction over substantially all of the assets or business of the Issuer, or if such jurisdiction has been assumed by leaving the existing governing body and officials or officers in possession but subject to the supervision and orders of a court or governmental authority, or the entry of an order confirming a plan of reorganization, arrangement or liquidation by a court or governmental authority having supervision or jurisdiction over substantially all of the assets or business of the Issuer:
  - (13) the consummation of a merger, consolidation, or acquisition involving the Issuer or the sale of all or substantially all of the assets of the Issuer, other than in the ordinary course of business, the entry into a definitive agreement to undertake such an action or the termination of a definitive agreement relating to any such actions, other than pursuant to its terms, if material: or
  - (14) appointment of a successor or additional trustee or the change of name of a trustee, if material.
- (e) Materiality Determined Under Federal Securities Laws. The Issuer agrees that its determination of whether any event listed in subsection (d) is material shall be made in accordance with federal securities laws.
- (f) Termination of Reporting Obligation. The Issuer reserves the right to terminate their obligation to provide annual financial information and notices of material events, as set forth above, if and when the Issuer is no

longer an "obligated person" with respect to the Bonds within the meaning of the Rule, including upon legal defeasance of all Bonds.

- (g) Identifying Information. All documents provided to the MSRB through EMMA shall be accompanied by the identifying information prescribed by the MSRB.
- (h) Benefit of Bondholders. The Issuer agrees that its undertaking pursuant to the Rule set forth in this Section is intended to be for the benefit of the Bondholders and shall be enforceable by any Bondholder; provided that, the right to enforce the provisions of this undertaking shall be limited to a right to obtain specific enforcement of the Issuer's obligations hereunder and any failure by the Issuer to comply with the provisions of this undertaking shall not constitute a default or an event of default with respect to the Bonds.
- Amendments to the Undertaking. Amendments may be made in the specific types of information provided or the format of the presentation of such information to the extent deemed necessary or appropriate in the judgment of the Issuer, provided that the Issuer agrees that any such amendment will be adopted procedurally and substantively in a manner consistent with the Rule, including any interpretations thereof by the SEC, which, to the extent applicable, are incorporated herein by reference. Such interpretations currently include the requirements that (a) the amendment may only be made in connection with a change in circumstances that arises from a change in legal requirements, change in law, or change in the identity, nature, or status of the Issuer or the type of activities conducted thereby, (b) the undertaking, as amended, would have complied with the requirements of the Rule at the time of the primary offering of the Bonds, after taking into account any amendments or interpretations of the Rule, as well as any change in circumstances, and (c) the amendment does not materially impair the interests of Bondholders, as determined by parties unaffiliated with the Issuer (such as independent legal counsel), but such interpretations may be changed in the future. If the accounting principles to be followed by the Issuer in the preparing of the Audited Financial Statements are modified, the annual financial information for the year in which the change is made shall present a comparison between the financial statements as prepared on the prior basis and the statements as prepared on the new basis, and otherwise shall comply with the requirements of the Rule, in order to provide information to investors to enable them to evaluate the ability of the Issuer to meet its obligations. A notice of the change in accounting principles shall be sent to the MSRB through EMMA.
- (j) Municipal Advisory Council of the State of Michigan. The Issuer shall also file by electronic or other means any information or notice required to be filed with the MSRB through EMMA pursuant to this Undertaking in a timely manner with the Municipal Advisory Council of the State of Michigan.

# AUTHORIZING MILLAGE ELECTION FOR THE COUNTY VETERANS SERVICES PROGRAM MILLAGE PROPOSAL AND CERTIFYING BALLOT LANGUAGE – VETERAN SERVICES

WHEREAS, A millage is necessary to serve Kalamazoo County veterans of active United States military service and their dependents;

WHEREAS, A County veterans' services program is essential to the citizens of the County of Kalamazoo;

WHEREAS, It is statutorily mandated to levy a millage of up to 1/10<sup>th</sup> of a mill (2/10<sup>th</sup> of a mill in emergencies) to fund the County Veterans Relief Fund per 1899 Public Act 214 (MCL 35.21 et seq.) for the funding of indigent veterans and their dependents claims, but that millage, if levied, does not fund the remaining cost of the Department of Veterans Affairs including any benefits or services to non-indigent veterans and their dependents;

WHEREAS, 0.10 mills is required to adequately provide County veterans services programs; and

WHEREAS, The Kalamazoo County Board of Commissioners has determined it is appropriate to submit a special millage proposition to the electors of the County at the election to be held on November 7, 2023 now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the following question be submitted to a vote of the electorate of Kalamazoo County at the election to be held Tuesday, November 7, 2023.

For the purpose of funding dedicated services and programs to Kalamazoo County veterans of United States military service, National Guard, and Reserves, and their dependents, including providing funding for the County Department of Veterans' Services, shall the constitutional limitation on general ad valorem taxes which may be assessed in any one (1) year upon all property within the County of Kalamazoo, Michigan, be increased by a reduced rate of up to a maximum of an additional 0.10 of one (1) mill (0.10 per \$1,000.00 of taxable value) for the period of ten (10) years from 2023 through 2032 inclusive? For example, on a property with a residential market value of \$200,000 (with an estimated taxable value of \$100,000), the .10 mills would equal approximately \$10 of levied tax annually to support veterans throughout Kalamazoo County.
