**SECTION 123.01 REPEAL, REVISION AND ENACTMENT OF ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS.**

(a) If an entire ordinance, resolution or section is to be repealed, it shall not be necessary to set forth in full that entire material. Instead, it shall be sufficient to refer to the language being repealed by its ordinance or resolution number or section number.

(b) If a resolution, ordinance or section thereof is to be revised instead of repealed, the amendment need not set forth the entire resolution, ordinance or section being changed, but may instead state what words are to be added, explain where they are to be inserted, and also set forth or identify any language to be deleted.

(c) Any ordinance or resolution may enact, repeal or amend a number of separate ordinances, resolutions or sections thereof as long as they all deal with the same general subject or are within the same code within the Codified Ordinances, e.g., the Traffic Code or Building Code.

**SECTION 123.02 PROCEDURE FOR PASSAGE OF RESOLUTIONS.**

Any resolution may be enacted at the same meeting at which it is introduced. No publication of the text or summary of a resolution shall be required.
