You are invited to compete in the 2024 Hispanic Heritage Art Contest

Celebrate National Hispanic Heritage Month through the arts! Cash prizes will be awarded through the Kettering Board of Community Relations (BCR) and submissions will be exhibited at Rosewood Arts Center in October 2024.

Hispanic Heritage Month became officially recognized in 1988 in the United States. BCR is excited to provide an opportunity for Kettering area students to celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month by learning about and honoring Hispanic and Latinx Artists.



Students in grades 6 - 12 are eligible! Prizes will be awarded in the following groups:

6th – 8th grade, 9th – 10th grade, 11th – 12th grade

FIRST PLACE: \$75 SECOND PLACE: \$50 THIRD PLACE: \$25

Artwork will be exhibited at Rosewood Arts Center October 21 – 26. An award ceremony and reception will take place on Saturday, October 19 at 1:30 p.m.

The Hispanic Heritage Month Art Contest is open to all students in 6th through 12th grade who live or attend school in Kettering. All submissions must be received by Friday, October 11, 2024. Artwork must be labeled and delivered to Rosewood Arts Center or the Information Desk of the City of Kettering.

GRADES 6 – 12

GENERAL RULES

1. Select an artist from the list provided.
2. Choose one of their famous works and reimagine it with a visual art form of your own interpretive style. It may be a painting, drawing, printmaking, sculpture, or photography
3. Provide an artist statement that includes the following:
 - A short bio of the original artist;
 - An explanation of why you chose them;
 - A statement explaining your process for re-imagining the artwork
4. Make sure to include your contact information in the submission including: teacher, school, your name, your guardian's name and contact information

CONTEST RULES

1. Grade groupings for winners will be 6th – 8th grade, 9th – 10th grade and 11th – 12th grade.
2. Winners will receive \$75 for first place, \$50 for second place and \$25 for third place.
3. Entries will be judged by the BCR Hispanic Heritage Month Art Contest Committee. Both the parent/guardian and the school will be notified in addition to the winner.
