

HOW YOUR TAX DOLLARS ARE SPENT

The City of Kettering wants you to know how your tax dollars are spent.



The construction of the multi-use path and replacement of drive approaches on Stroop Road will be complete in coming weeks. The resurfacing of the roadway will be the final step in the project and should be complete by the end of November.

In early September, Montgomery County will begin a water main replacement project on Shroyer Road. The City of Kettering is coordinating closely with Montgomery County and the Kettering City Schools on this project which is expected to take 6-8 weeks. Following the completion of the water main project, Vectren will be installing a gas main under the walk on both sides of Shroyer Road. It is anticipated that this work will only require curb lane closures. The City of Kettering will be milling and paving Shroyer Road in the summer of 2017.

The City of Kettering Board of Zoning Appeals is pond edging. While the work on the pond is now complete, the lack of rainfall has delayed the restoration of water levels. Because of the drought, it is anticipated that the water levels will not fully return to normal level until 2017. As a result the City of Kettering parks department will take additional measures to ensure the maintenance of the pond area.

UPDATE ON CONSTRUCTION OF FIRE STATIONS



Fire Station 32 at 3484 Far Hills Avenue is fully operational and is surpassing expectations with regard to meeting the needs of the community.

Construction of Fire Station 36 at 4745 Hempstead Station Road is complete and in the final stages of preparation before becoming fully operational in September. In addition to being a 24/7 fire station, this facility will serve as Fire Department Headquarters, Emergency Operations Center, and our Backup Dispatch and Data Center.

Construction recently started on Fire Station 34 at 2575 Woodman Drive directly south of Tenneco.

Fire Station 37 will be located at 1300 West Dorothy Lane. The planning and design of this station is underway. Construction of this station is expected to begin during the summer of 2017.

PRCA FALL ACTIVITIES GUIDE



Construction is underway on the Prugh Woods development located at the intersection of Dorothy Lane and Prentice Drive near the Kettering Recreation Complex. The initial work will involve the clearing of the property to allow for construction of the access road and preparation of residential lots for home construction. The bulk of the heavy construction should be complete by the end of 2016, with the construction of new homes to continue in to next year as the home sites are sold.

The Prugh Woods development will include construction of a new access road to the Kettering Recreation Complex from East Dorothy Lane, which will be named Prugh Woods Drive. A multi-use pedestrian/bicycle pathway will be constructed along Prugh Woods Drive with a connection to Westcott Drive.




