VACATING PART OF A UTILITY EASEMENT IN THE STROOP SUBDIVISION AND TAIT ROAD PLAT

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2017 the Planning Commission in Case No. PC-17-008 considered and recommended approval of an application to vacate part of a utility easement in the Stroop Subdivision and Tait Road Plat; and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2017, this Council held a public hearing on the application and Planning Commission's recommendation and during the public hearing no party came forward in opposition; and

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause for the vacation, that the vacation will not be detrimental to the public interest, and that such vacation should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1</u>. Approval is hereby granted for the vacation of part of a utility easement on Lots 17 and 21 of the Stroop Subdivision and Tait Road Plat, recorded in Plat Book Y, Page 48, as described and depicted in the attached Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Clerk of Council is directed and authorized to prepare a certified copy of this Ordinance, and the Planning and Development Director of this City is hereby directed and authorized to accept the certified copy of this Ordinance from the Clerk of Council and, upon satisfaction of all Planning Commission conditions, if any, to further cause that same certified ordinance and any other necessary documents to be properly delivered to the Montgomery County Recorder for appropriate recordation. The City Manager is authorized to sign any instruments necessary to effectuate the vacation.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Ordinance shall take full effect from and after the earliest period provided by law.

Description of Part of a Utility Easement
To Be Vacated Upon Lot 17 and 21,
Stroop Subdivision and Tait Road
City of Kettering, Montgomery County, Ohio

Situate in Section 4, Town 1, Range 6 M.Rs., City of Kettering, Montgomery County, Ohio and being part of a utility easement upon Lots 17 and 21 of the Stroop Subdivision and Tait Road as recorded in Plat Book Y, Page 48 of the plat records of said county to be vacated, said easement being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point of curvature at the northwest corner of Lot 17;

thence northeastwardly on a curve to the right having a radius of 475.51 feet an arc distance of 5.09 feet to a point, (said curve having a central angle of 0°36′47″, a chord bearing of N 62°06′33″ E and a chord distance of 5.09 feet);


thence S 17°07'00" E a distance of 266.46 feet to a point;

thence S 79°01'30" W a distance of 10.06 feet to a point;

thence N 17°07'00" W a distance of 263.42 feet to a point of curvature;

thence northeastwardly on a curve to the right having a radius of 475.51 feet an arc distance of 5.10 feet to the point of beginning and terminus of the herein described easement (said curve having a central angle of 0°36′53″, a chord bearing of N 61°29′43″ E and a chord distance of 5.10 feet).
