The annual Kettering Community Block Party is a free event where you can learn more about living, working and playing in the community of choice- Kettering!



FIRE HYDRANT INSPECTIONS

During hydrant inspections, water may appear brown from the disturbance of mineral deposits. While these deposits pose no threat to health or safety, they could be alarming and they could also discolor clothing. The Fire Department suggests that if hydrants are inspected in your neighborhood, you should check water before starting laundry. If brown water is observed, simply run cold water until it clears.

commonly known as door to door sales.

As the weather continues improve, door-to-door solicitors become more active.

While there is no ordinance in Kettering banning solicitors, you have rights as a home owner.

Here are some tips our Kettering Police Departments suggests you consider:

-Hang a "No Soliciting" Sign.

-Don't answer the door.

-Keep your screen door shut and locked (if you have one) while talking to the solicitor.

- Ask for identification and soliciting permit.

-Do research on the company or individual selling the product.

-Never pay with cash.

-Write checks out to a company, not an individual.

-Get a written receipt with business name, phone number and address.

-You have three days to cancel purchases over \$25 made in your home or at a location that is not the seller's permanent place of more information on planning a block party in your neighborhood <u>click here</u>.

The City of Kettering is committed to investment in projects aimed at preserving our infrastructure and meeting the commercial and residential needs of our citizens.

Work is already underway on the entire length of Stroop Road from South Dixie Drive to Dorothy Lane. From South Dixie Drive to Shroyer Road the project improvements will include milling off approximately 2.5 inches of the old asphalt off and replacing with new asphalt along with improving handicap ramps to meet current standards at the intersections.

The East Stroop Road portion of the project will involve the construction of a 10 feet wide sidewalk from Glengarry Drive to Wilmington Pike plus asphalt resurfacing along East Stroop from Dorothy Lane to Shroyer Road. Both portions of the Stroop Road project will be complete by mid-summer.

We have several other repaving projects underway or planned for this spring and summer including Lincoln Park Boulevard from Far Hills to Ackerman, Delco Park Drive, Gateway Circle and numerous residential neighborhoods. We will also focus on curb, drive approach and sidewalk repair in select neighborhoods. To learn more about road construction projects <u>click</u> <u>here</u>.

In the coming weeks construction will begin on the Prugh Woods residential development located at the intersection of Dorothy Lane and Prentice Drive near the Kettering Recreation Complex. The initial work will involve the clearing of the property to allow for construction of the access road and preparation of residential lots for home construction.
