- Submissions may be hand delivered between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m. Wednesday, January 4 through Friday, February 10, 2017.
- Winners will be divided into appropriate age groupings (depending on number of submissions received) and will be determined by members of the Board of Community Relations.
- Winners will be invited to attend a February City Council meeting for recognition.
- Writing submissions should include the application form below and will not be returned.
- Submissions that do not meet the criteria, that plagiarize others' work, or that do not include a complete application form will not be considered.
