
Q1 Are you over the age of 18 and a Kettering resident?



Q2 Below are some common concerns of Kettering citizens. Please choose the three (3) issues that are your greatest concerns in our community right now.



Q3 Please rate the Kettering Police Department on a scale from 1 (poor) to 5 (excellent) on their attention to the following common issues of concern.





- The only reason gave such a low score above, is with a prior neighbor in the rental house next door they did not show just one of the signs of being a potential drug seller, but they showed ALL of the signs law enforcement look for. And our neighborhood is very close to the city of Kettering government office and KPD headquarters in the Ackerman and Brubaker area. Example: When the guy who lived next door was in town over 23 different vehicles would come to that house often staying just for minutes, cars would pull-up even during the middle of the night at times then people would go inside that rental house for 5 to 15 minutes then leave, also if there were no vehicles parked in front of that house or any other houses nearby there were people who would park 100 to 150 yards down the street in front of other homes then walk to the rental house next door, then overheard the conversations of those who lived in the house next door several times and they were talking about drugs they had to include marijuana and cocaine.

Thankfully those neighbors moved.

But there are way more important issues to worry about than whether I'm dropping my daughter off in the "drop off" zone in front of Oakview Elementary. Harassing me, swarming me as though I'm a criminal because I need to quickly drop off my child in front of the school and get to work on time is WAY OVERKILL. Sorry, but you know that it is. I'm a single mom of three kids, going to work everyday, trying to get my kids off to school....I don't have time to go around the school building and sit and wait for the school to open the doors. I will be late for work everyday. My daughter is also part of safety patrol, she's a good, respectful student, and so in her best interest I will pull in to the parking lot so she can walk over to the front door. But understand, I've been dropping my kids off in front of that school for 7 years now, and never had an issue like this, until this year. So please note that I find it ridiculous to be "cracking down" on the issue of parents dropping their kids off in the actual drop off zone in front of a school. Other than that, I have the utmost respect, and think you guys do a great job! Thank you!
- Traffic issues and child safety issues continue to be HUGE in the area of Fairmont HS and Van Buren. Accidents every day and driving over there during start and end of day are a nightmare. My daughter actually prayed for the number of people in Fairmont (where she attends) who have been involved in car accidents. Ironic considering the police station is right across the street. Also the school zone around Beavertown is not monitored very well. The parking for Ascension sports games at the entrance to Forrer Point (by the car wash) and the people running across Forrer at those times is also out of control.
- As a father with two young children, I'm constantly anxious about schools being gun-free zones and therefore a target for gun violence.





In regard to being more attentive, about 3 years ago during the middle of the night had what was an apparent attempted home invasion. After staying up all night to make sure the house was secure, that same morning two KPD officers were parked across the street talking with a neighbor. When I went over to those two KPD officers, told them "someone had ran into my house very hard early in the morning". The KPD officers glanced at my house from the home across the street where KPD was parked, then both of the KPD officers began laughing. Because I was so tired from staying up all night to make sure my home was secure, I did not perhaps phrase my words properly because of being so tired. However if either of those two KPD officers would have taken time to say "what do you mean someone ran into your house" then I would have replied someone ran into the side door of my house as hard as they could with their body rattling all the rafters inside the home. Additionally if the KPD officers would have even investigated, they would have seen the dent in the metal door where it was kicked with a foot or knee. Did not help to provide much confidence in KPD when a homeowner is trying to report a suspected home invasion, and both officers just begin laughing.

Officer's of Kettering don't offer a feeling of protection in this city. It feels more like they're covering for themselves and their jobs instead of being concerned about reducing crime or protecting citizens.






Q21 How long have you lived in your current residence?




Q22 In what zip code is your residence located? Answered 126-Skipped 66




Q24 Do you rent or own your Kettering residence?


Q26 What is your age?


Q27 What is your gender?


Q28 Do you have children under the age of 18 living in your home?


Q29 What is your marital status?


