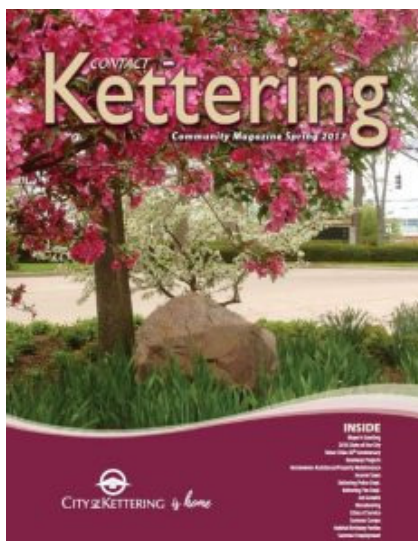
KETTERING IS HOME

KETTERING SISTER CITIES INTERNATIONAL YOUTH EXCHANGE

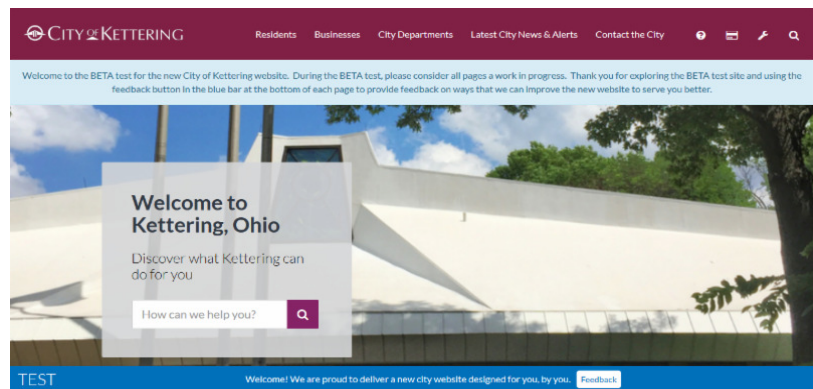

The City of Kettering is a proud partner in the new SilverLink service. SilverLink is a free and confidential information and referral service for seniors administered by the United Way of Greater Dayton. Just dial 2-1-1 or call 225-3000 to reach help 24 hours a day.

United Way of Greater Dayton will be hosting a community meeting in Kettering to share information about the new SilverLink program with residents.



In order to improve our ability to serve you, we are launching a brand new city website.

With so many sources of information out there, we want to ensure that it is easy for you to get timely, accurate information directly from the City of Kettering.

Also, we want to make it as convenient and efficient as possible for you to request city services or report concerns.

The new site, focused on helping you better access services and information, includes:

- a brand new design that organizes information in a more user intuitive format and places the focus on customer service
- a responsive design that adapts to phones, tablets, laptops or computers and, if the user desires, can function much like an app
- a simple search that makes it easier to find information and services
- an 'Answers' tool that lets users quickly access frequently asked questions and a 'Report an Issue' tool that allows you to submit concerns with one click
- integration with city social media accounts including being able to find answers to frequently asked questions and report issues directly from our city Facebook page

The new website will go live later this year, but first, we're starting with "BETA"—a testing and feedback phase before we make it our official site.

For a short period of time, the public BETA site will exist in tandem with our current city website.

This is where we are asking for your help to make the new website meet your needs.

ENROLL TO RECEIVE CODE RED EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS AND COMMUNITY ALERTS



Did you know that in addition to our City of Kettering Facebook page and Twitter posts the City of Kettering uses a system called Code Red to notify our residents of emergency incidents and critical community alerts?

Please take a moment to enroll.

When you enroll in Code Red, you may opt to receive alerts on your home or cell phone, by email and by text. Please note that because of the emergency nature of some alerts, notices may be received at all hours. Should you wish, you can easily decide later to opt out from receiving future alerts. Please be aware that if you opt out, you will not receive any future notifications including communication about interruptions in service or news that is relevant to you.
