# AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND TO CONTRACT FOR THE OAK CREEK PHASE 3 IMPROVEMENTS, CITY PROJECT NO. 02-290

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and to enter into one or more contracts for the Oak Creek Phase 3 Improvements, City Project No. 02-290, which will consist of concrete repair of deteriorating curb, sidewalk and drive approaches as well as a mill and overlay of the roadway surface on the following streets in the neighborhood south of Whipp Road and East of Bigger Road: Andrew Drive, Arimont Circle, Brookbank Drive, Brookbank Place, Brookpart Drive, Dody Circle, Fairhill Lane, Millwood Road, Montbellow Circle, Oak Valley Road, Oakshire Circle, Overbrooke Road, Pondview Drive, Shadow Oaks Place, Timber Oak Circle, Whispering Willow Circle, and Wrenside Lane; in accordance with Chapter 152 of the Kettering Administrative Code, entitled Purchases and Contracts.

Section 2. Bids for such project shall be in accordance with the specifications on file in the Department of Finance, office of the Purchasing Manager. Bidding may be conducted electronically. The bids shall be opened at the time and place named in the advertisement for bids, unless extended by the City; or unless, within seventy-two hours prior to the published time for the opening of bids, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, any modification of the plans or specifications for the project for which bids are solicited is issued and mailed or otherwise furnished to persons who have obtained plans or specifications for the project in which event the time for opening of bids shall be extended one week, with no further advertising of bids required.

Section 3. The City of Kettering shall and does reserve the right (a) to reject any or all bids so received, (b) to waive any irregularities in a bid, (c) to hold any bid up to sixty (60) days unless the time for awarding the contract is extended by mutual consent of the City and the bidder whose bid the City subsequently accepts or, (d) to accept that bid which in the judgment of the City Manager is in the best interest of the City.

DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF REPAIRING CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVE APPROACHES AS PART OF THE VALLEYWOOD DRIVE PHASE 2 – CEMETERY LANE TO EAST DOROTHY LANE PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 02-232B)

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. It is necessary for the health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Kettering to construct or repair the curbs, sidewalks, and/or drive approaches, and related appurtenances at locations shown on Exhibit A attached hereto, as part of the Valleywood Drive Phase 2 – Cemetery Lane to East Dorothy Lane Project, as set forth below and as shown on the plans and specifications for Project Number 02-232B (the "Project").

<u>Section 2</u>. The Project plans, specifications, and cost estimates previously filed in the Office of the Clerk of Council are approved.

<u>Section 3</u>. The lots and lands abutting upon the Project to be constructed or repaired are the lots and lands shown on the attached Exhibit A.

<u>Section 4</u>. The curbs, sidewalks, and drive/or approaches identified for construction or repair in the Project plans and specifications shall be constructed or repaired by the owners of the abutting lots or lands in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 5. The deadline for construction or repair of such curbs, sidewalks, and/or drive approaches by the owners of the lots and lands abutting thereon shall not be less than thirty (30) days and not more than forty-five (45) days from the date of service of notice upon the owners of the lots and lands and as required under Section 729.03 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 6</u>. In the event such curbs, sidewalks, and/or drive approaches are not constructed or repaired by the owners of the lots and lands abutting thereon in accordance with such plans and specifications and within the time prescribed by this Resolution, then the City of Kettering will so construct or repair such curbs, sidewalks and/or drive approaches and assess the cost thereof against the lots and lands abutting thereon.

<u>Section 7</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations resulting in formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

<u>Section 8</u>. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be served according to law by the Clerk of Council or the Clerk's designee upon the owner(s) of the lots and lands shown on the attached Exhibit A.

Section 9. This Resolution shall take full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

Section 1. Section 2. Bids for such project shall be in accordance with the specifications on file in the Department of Finance, Office of the Purchasing Manager. Bidding may be conducted electronically. The bids shall be opened at the time and place named in the advertisement for bids, unless extended by the City; or unless, within seventy-two hours prior to the published time for the opening of bids, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays, any modification of the plans or specifications for the project for which bids are solicited is issued and mailed or otherwise furnished to persons who have obtained plans or specifications for the project in which event the time for opening of bids shall be extended one week, with no further advertising of bids required.

Section 3. The City of Kettering shall and does reserve the right (a) to reject any or all bids so received, (b) to waive any irregularities in a bid, (c) to hold any bid up to sixty (60) days unless the time for awarding the contract is extended by mutual consent of the City and the bidder whose bid the City subsequently accepts or, (d) to accept that bid which, in the judgment of the City Manager, is in the best interest of the City.

In December 2017 a replat was approved by the Kettering Planning Commission that allows for the reconfiguration of the property line between these two entities. The current rezoning case involves a request to adjust the zoning boundary that is necessitated by the reconfiguration of the lot lines separating these two entities. The new property to be acquired by the Wynds Apartments would be designated R-4 (multi-family residential), and the new land to be added to the Dayton Metro Library branch would be zoned O – Office.

The Planning Commission made findings in their approval motion that all required standards for the proposed rezoning have been met.
