Candidates will be emailed a copy of their exam reservation confirmation form with their ID number prior to the date of the exam. This document must be presented at the examination site.

The examination being administered is the **National Firefighter Selection Inventory (NFSI)**. The *NFSI Study Guide* is available to familiarize you with and better prepare you for this exam. It is the responsibility of each applicant to see that they receive a study guide. This Study Guide is available in the Human Resources office and is provided to you free of charge. Regular business hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 am-5:00 pm.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Civil Service examination process will consist of a written examination. Applicants receiving a passing score on this exam will be notified regarding subsequent phases of processing, which will include:

- Background check (credit, police record, work and personal references, etc.)
- Personal interview
- Polygraph
- Psychological assessment
- Thorough medical examination and assessment of physical capabilities
- Successful completion of a one-year probationary period

NOTE: Any information of a criminal or illegal nature which surfaces during this process will be forwarded to the appropriate enforcement investigative agency for prosecution.

Inability to satisfactorily complete any phase of this process may be cause for elimination from consideration. Failure to appear for any phase may also result in elimination. Because of the nature of the examination, applicants will not be permitted to review the examination afterward.

Examination Information: The written exam will be held at 9:00 a.m. on October 20, 2018. The exam will be held at Fairmont High School, 3301 Shroyer Road, Kettering, OH 45429. All applicants must have an application and exam reservation on file with the City by October 8, 2018, in order to participate in this exam. In addition to the exam reservation confirmation form, all applicants must bring one of the following documents to the written exam site:

- 1) Driver's license
- 2) Military ID
- 3) Passport
- 4) Other Federal or State issued photo ID

Applications: Applications will be accepted Monday-Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. through October 8, 2018. Materials may be mailed to out-of-town applicants; however, filing deadlines must be met for consideration.

Lateral entry candidates are encouraged to apply.

THE POSITION

Entry-level Firefighter/Paramedics work under supervision in the extinguishment of fires, investigation and analysis of fires, enforcement of fire codes, and emergency medical service. The recruit remains at entry level for a minimum of one year, during which time proficiency in the basic operative skills must be acquired through formal instruction and on-the-job training.

Advancement within rank from one level of Firefighter to the next higher level of Firefighter is based on the demonstrated attainment of a higher level of skill and expertise. There are minimum service requirements at each pay grade. Firefighters who meet specified service and skill requirements are eligible to compete for promotion to Captain with requisite number of years of service.


Applicants should be aware that successful completion of extensive formal and on-the-job training will be required during the initial probationary period.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

Salary range is \$65,686 per year to \$86,278 per year with entry rate dependent upon experience and training. Extensive fringe benefits include medical and dental insurance, life insurance, attractive retirement plan under the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund, paid holidays, vacation, sick leave, etc.

THE CITY

Additional personnel include the City's Fire Marshal, a Fire Service Specialist, a part-time Fire Inspector and two Administrative Assistants.

QUALIFICATIONS

State of Ohio EMT-B and Level II Firefighter is required at the time of application. State of Ohio EMT/Paramedic certification is not required at the time of test or application; however, it is required at the time of interview to be considered for appointment. Continued recertification is required throughout one's career.

Age – Must be at least 18 years of age at time of appointment.

Physical condition/Visual Acuity – Must be physically capable of performing all essential functions of a Firefighter/Paramedic. Applicants must be free of any disqualifying medical condition that results in not being able to perform the essential functions of the Firefighter/Paramedic position. Must pass a thorough medical examination and an assessment of physical capabilities consistent with National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) medical standards. Any final questions about a candidate's physical condition, capacity, etc. will be resolved prior to appointment based on a recommendation provided by a doctor selected by the City.

Ohio Operator's License – Within 60 days of appointment, appointee must obtain a valid State of Ohio Driver's License.

U.S. Citizen – Must be a United States citizen or have a valid permanent resident card at time of application.

MORE INFORMATION

Civil Service eligibility lists are generally used for a minimum of one year, with the potential of two separate, six-month extensions. Unless otherwise specified, candidates not chosen during one recruitment are not necessarily excluded from further consideration and may participate in future recruitments. 
