903.01 SIDEWALK AND CURB REPAIRS.

Sidewalks and curbs shall be repaired to conform to the walks and curbs they adjoin unless such adjoining walks are not in conformity with the requirements of the City Engineer, in which event as much of the sidewalk as in the opinion of the City Engineer requires repairs, shall be reconstructed to conform to such requirements; provided, however, that temporary repairs may be made of such materials and in such manner as may be approved by the City Engineer. 903.02 CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS, CURBS AND DRIVEWAY APRONS.

Whenever any sidewalks, curbs or driveway aprons within the street area, and related work or installation are constructed, repaired or altered, such construction shall be subject to inspection and approval by the City Engineer as to plans and installation, and the work shall be in conformity with the requirements prescribed by the City Engineer and in conformity with the established grade of such street areas. 903.99 PENALTY.

Whoever violates any of the provisions of this chapter shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor for the first offense. A second violation of any of the provisions of this chapter by the same person within one year after the first violation, whether of exactly the same section or not, shall constitute a fourth degree misdemeanor.
