MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Education: At time of appointment, must have obtained credit hours equivalent to an Associate Degree (60 semester hours / 90 quarter hours) from an accredited college or university.
- Physical Condition: Must be physically capable of performing essential police duties and pass a thorough medical examination, which may include meeting Academy physical fitness entrance standards as required by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (O.P.O.T.C.); and a drug/ alcohol screen.
- Possess or obtain a valid State of Ohio Operator's License.
- Must be 21 years of age and must be eligible to work in the United States at the time of appointment.
- Lateral Entry: Candidates who possess an O.P.O.T.C. certificate or equivalent peace officer certificate in another state, and have been employed as a full-time peace officer within the last calendar year from due date of application, may be hired in at a higher pay step. Lateral Entry candidates must also meet the requirements listed above.
- All candidates, regardless of experience are ranked on the eligibility list by order of their test score on the written exam.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Civil Service examination process will consist of a written examination. Applicants receiving a passing score on this exam will be notified regarding subsequent phases of the process, which will include:

- Background check including but not limited to (credit, criminal history, work and personal references, etc.)
- Personal interview
- Polygraph
- Psychological assessment
- Thorough medical examination and assessment of physical capabilities, including passage of Academy minimum physical fitness standards

NOTE: Any information of a criminal or illegal nature which surfaces during this process will be forwarded to the appropriate enforcement investigative agency for prosecution.

Inability to satisfactorily complete any phase of this process may be cause for elimination from consideration. Failure to appear for any phase may also result in elimination. Because of the nature of the written examination, applicants will not be permitted to review the examination afterward.

Examination Information: Two written examination dates are being offered, March 9, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. and March 12, 2019 at 6:30 p.m. The exams will be held at Fairmont High School, 3301 Shroyer Road, Kettering, OH 45429 and candidates may participate on only one of the exam dates. All applicants must have an application and exam reservation on file with the City by 5:00 p.m. on March 1, 2019, in order to participate in this exam. In addition to the exam reservation confirmation form, all applicants must bring one of the following documents to the written exam site:

THE POSITION

Duties and work requirements consist of preventive patrol, preliminary investigations, and traffic control in designated areas. It may also include a variety of staff assignments, such as criminal investigations, research and development, and community relations.

Duties may involve an element of personal danger and employees must be able to act without immediate and direct supervision, and exercise independent judgment in addressing emergencies. The nature of the work requires irregular schedules, covering all hours of the day, 365 days a year.

Patrol Officers who meet specified service and skill requirements are eligible to compete for promotion to a supervisory position.

Applicants should be of exemplary character and be able to demonstrate traits that are consistent with the mission and values of the Kettering Police Department.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Education Requirements — At time of appointment, must have obtained credit hours equivalent to an Associate Degree (60 semester hours / 90 quarter hours) from an accredited college or university.

Physical Condition — Must be physically capable of performing essential police duties and pass a thorough medical examination, where applicable, candidate must meet Academy minimum physical fitness entrance standards as required by Ohio Peace Officer Training Commission (O.P.O.T.C.); and a drug/alcohol screening.

Ohio Operator's License — Appointee must possess or obtain a valid State of Ohio Operator's License.

U.S. Citizen — Must be eligible to work in the United States at time of appointment. Candidates must be at least 21 years of age at the time of appointment.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

Salary range for 2019 is \$32.45 per hour (\$67,496 per year) to \$43.82 per hour (\$91,146 per year) with entry rate dependent upon experience and training. Extensive fringe benefits include medical and dental insurance, life insurance, attractive retirement plan under the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund, paid holidays, vacation leave and sick leave.

MORE INFORMATION

Civil Service eligibility lists are generally used for a minimum of one year, with the potential of two separate six-month extensions.
