County Probation Violation Warrants

When an officer arrests someone on a county probation violation warrant, and it looks like they will be admitted to a hospital or it will be an extended stay, you can call Mr. Yerkins and, if appropriate under the circumstances, he can provide authorization to:

- 1. Advise hospital security to call him (Mr. Yerkins) when the prisoner will be released.
- 2. Or he may have you tell the prisoner to report to his probation officer when he/she is released.
