III. Operational Procedure

- A. Responding Officers
 - 1. Develop tentative plan en route to call
 - 2. Take immediate steps to insure safety of bystanders and responding officers
 - 3. Notify on duty watch commander
 - 4. Secure the perimeter
- B. Barricaded Suspects
 - 1. Cordon off barricaded situation to minimize danger to all person involved
 - 2. Establish perimeter to cut off escape
 - 3. Take up safe position and wait until relieved
 - 4. Once relieved report to Command Post
- C. Bomb threats

1. Radio traffic will cease within 1000 yards of scene
 - a. Use land line, not cell phone for communications
 2. Search of premises will be conducted with an adult familiar with location
 3. Evacuation is at discretion of adult responsible for property
 - a. Civilians should not move suspicious or unidentified objects
 4. Undetonated devices
 - a. **Evacuate all people to a safe distance**
 - b. No one shall touch or tamper with device
 5. Supervisor will contact either Dayton Bomb Squad or Wright Patterson Air Force Base EOD Team
- D. Reports
1. Incident report
- E. Shooting situation involving officer
1. Immediately after shooting
 - a. Keep subject covered until back-up arrives
 - b. Once back-up arrives secure subject
 - c. Call for Medic for subject as soon as possible
 - d. Call for Supervisor
 2. Investigation of Shooting
 - a. Detectives will respond for investigation into criminal aspect
 1. Officer is now suspect in shooting
 2. Detective will read rights to officer and question same
 3. Case will go in front of County Prosecutor for review for criminal charges
 4. Officer will be put on Administrative Leave with pay
 - a. Will be sent to Psychologist
 - b. Internal Affairs will investigate shooting for administrative purpose
 - a. Internal Affairs will read Garrity rights to officer
 - b. Officer will be interviewed by IA Sergeant
 3. Emotional survival after shooting
 - a. Have a plan for support after shooting
 - b. Identify people for your support
 - c. How you are going to explain to family and friends
