- A. Verify ownership of vehicle by running registration check
- B. Verify identity and ensure person requesting assistance is owner, family member, or other person authorized to drive the car, WW check
- C. Have owner/operator complete Lock Out Card/Move Release
- D. If safety of person(s) in vehicle is in jeopardy, use whatever means which is reasonably necessary to gain entry into vehicle
- E. Turn in Lock Out Card even if unsuccessful
- F. We open doors with electric locks with the "big easy" tool.
- G. Move Release: Instruct person to put vehicle in neutral and slowly ease foot off of brake. Push vehicle into safe place, check to see if person is okay.
