- A. Types of Abnormalities
  - 1. Alzheimer /Dementia
  - 2. Developmentally Disabled
  - 3. Mental disorders
    - a. Schizophrenia
    - b. Paranoid Schizophrenia
    - c. Paranoia
    - d. Manic Depressive
  - 4. Deaf
  - 5. Epilepsy

- 6. Visual Impairment
- 7. Delirium Short onset of dementia less than 1 month symptoms look like Alzheimer's, but is due to acute illness
- B. Hazard/threat
  - 1. UNPREDICTABLE
  - 2. Danger to themselves
  - Combative/hostile
- C. Safety measures
  - 1. Deal **calmly** with subject
  - 2. Move slowly and quietly
  - 3. Protect your weapon
  - 4. Remove all potential weapons
  - 5. Seek professional help
    - a. KMH
    - b. Miami Valley
    - c. Haven Behavioral Hospital (Mental Health Hospital for Seniors (60+) only
    - d. Elizabeth Place (Dayton 234-0100)
  - 6. Involve family and/or friends
    - a. They can sign them into KMH
  - 7. Emergency Hospitalization
    - a. Any police officer
    - b. Patient is mentally ill subject to hospitalization
      - 1. Must be mentally ill (includes suicidal, homicidal subjects)
      - 2. Threats to himself or others
      - 3. Shows a failure to care of one's own basic needs
      - 4. Can voluntarily sign themselves in for evaluation
    - c. Contact Supervisor
    - d. Transport subject to KMH (can use medic if necessary)
      - 1. May handcuff for officer safety (two officers transport)
      - 2. Advise them name, rank, department, not a criminal arrest, for examination only, and the facility you are going to
      - 3. Remain with subject until assessed
      - 4. Sign Involuntary Admission Form (pink form)
        - a. Give copy of report to facility
      - 5. KFD may transport subject also
  - E. Report on Memo if taken to a medical facility. Get a copy of the pink slip
  - 1. Document **ALL** abnormal behaviors
  - 2. Record all threats even to self
  - 3. Actions you took and reason for them
  - 4. Enter into hot address file on Teletype Form if needed
- F. Abuse/Neglect of Elderly

- 1. Police officer required to report
- 2. Must have reasonable cause
- 3. Adult suffering abuse, self-neglect, neglect, or exploitation
- 4. Notify Adult Protective Services 225-4906
  - a. Send them your Incident Report
