TASK # 40

Purpose

The officer will complete paperwork for stolen and recovered vehicles.
The officer will initiate a high risk traffic stop if vehicle is occupied

III. Operational Procedure

- A. Further investigation
 - 1. Are all keys accounted for?
 - 2. Is the car paid off?
 - a. Are payments up to date
 - b. Obtain lien holder and balance
 - c. Check with dispatch that the vehicle is not a repossession
 - 3. Obtain copy of title and registration
 - 4. Fill out teletype request and get supervisor to check it
 - a. Have dispatch enter car into NCIC
 - 5. Put out broadcast via MDT
 - 6. Note approximate mileage if known
 - 7. Note approximate amount of gas
 - 8. Contents of vehicle (smoker/non-smoker)
 - 9. List unusual things about the vehicle

- C. Recovery of occupied Stolen Vehicle
 - 1. Call for back up
 - 2. Execute High Risk Traffic Stop
 - 3. Secure subjects and scene
 - 4. Verify with originating agency
 - 5. Request Evidence crew (if KPD stolen or request of other agency)
- B. Recovery of unoccupied vehicle
 - 1. KPD entered stolen
 - a. Request Evidence Crew
 - b. Secure scene
 - 2. Other agency stolen
 - a. Verify and notify reporting agency
 - 3. Note damage, column peeled, amount of gas, mileage, contents, etc.
- C. Reports
 - 1. Kettering Police Department grand theft
 - a. Formal complaint
 - b. Synopsis
 - 1. KPD recovered entered stolen
 - a. Synopsis with original event number listed
 - 2. Other agency recovered stolen
 - a. Memo
 - b. Synopsis
