 - 1. Contact dispatch and provide vehicle information and type of tow
 - 2. Complete the ticket and have subject sign release if warranted
 - 3. Complete inventory whenever vehicle is towed and a tow ticket is filled out except owners request and accident where driver is not transported to hospital
 - 4. Assist tow truck driver and citizens
 - 5. Only vehicle keys go with towed vehicle
 - 6. Item of substantial value place in property room
- B. Abandoned/Junk vehicle--know definition
 - 1. Can tow if unattended on public street
 - 2. Attempt to contact owner if possible
 - 3. If Vehicle is towed it must be photographed and attach photo with tow ticket
