III. Operational Procedure

- A. Warrant Log
 - 1. Receive warrant log and copy of affidavit or citations
 - a. Check that information is correct
 - b. <u>CHECK WITH DISPATCH, OR HAND CHECK IT</u> YOURSELF, TO VERIFY WARRANT IS STILL ACTIVE
 - c. Within city limits get with another officer
 - 1. Meet with officer near location of service

- 2. Share information on subject
- 3. Notify dispatch and attempt service
 - a. Check residence for car
 - b. Listen for activity
- 4. If subject is at his own residence but will not answer door or other family member tells you they are not home, contact supervisor for possible forced entry
- 5. Use discretion
- 6. Arrest subject
- d. Outside jurisdiction
 - 1. Notify supervisor
 - 2. Call for back up from jurisdiction you are going to within city limits
 - 3. Warrant has to be a KMC warrant to arrest outside the jurisdiction.
- 2. List all attempts of service on Warrant Log. Turn completed warrant log into Sergeant's desk
 - 1. Ones that were served, not served, or canceled
- B. Warrants on traffic stops and suspicious subjects.
 - 1. Obtain a second crew
 - 2. Confirm all warrants before arresting subjects
 - 3. May place subject in handcuffs for safety purposes while waiting for confirmation
