



Pursuant to Subsection I of Section 152.02 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Kettering, the City Manager is hereby authorized to contract with Kastle Electric Company for installation of network cabling and related appurtenances in Lincoln Park. The City Manager is further authorized to sign any amendments or extensions thereto that the City Manager deems appropriate.
