WHEREAS, the City of Kettering is currently planning to make capital improvements with the following project(s):

1. Ridgeway Road Bridge Replacement (Project No. 03-904C, PID 108706);

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvements described above are considered to be a priority need for the community and are qualified projects under the OPWC programs;

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S MUNICIPAL BRIDGE PROGRAM FOR FUNDING OF THE ANSEL DRIVE BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT AND THE DANUBE COURT BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation's ("ODOT") Municipal Bridge Program ("Program) provides Federal funds to municipal corporations for roadway bridge replacement and bridge rehabilitation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kettering is currently planning the following roadway bridge replacement/rehabilitation projects:

- 1. Ansel Drive Bridge Rehabilitation Project (City Project No. 03-947);
- 2. Danube Court Bridge Rehabilitation Project (City Project 03-924A); and

WHEREAS, the roadway bridge projects identified above are qualified projects under the ODOT Municipal Bridge Program;

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO USE COMPETITIVE BARGAINING AND NEGOTIATED QUOTES TO CONTRACT FOR RESURFACING THE INTERSECTION OF EAST STROOP/COUNTY LINE AND EAST DOROTHY LANE/INDIAN RIPPLE ROADS

Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. On the basis that the City can often obtain lower prices and more favorable purchasing conditions through competitive bargaining and negotiated quotations than through sealed bids, the City Manager is hereby authorized to use such bargaining and negotiation procedures to contract for the resurfacing (including, without limitation milling) of the intersection of East Stroop/County Line and East Dorothy Lane/Indian Ripple Roads (the "Project"). The City manager is further authorized to enter into a cooperation and cost sharing agreement for the Project with the City of Beavercreek and to split the costs of the Project 50-50. The City Manager is further authorized to sign any amendments or extensions to any contract authorized herein that the City Manager deems appropriate

<u>Section 2.</u> As provided in Section 4-8 of the City Charter, this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
