In 2009, citizens in Dayton, Ohio voiced concerns about the dangerous journey faced by bus riders who had to cross a busy interstate overpass on foot to get to their employment, shopping, medical, and educational destinations. What followed was a series of policy and publicity battles and a two-year investigation by the Federal Highway Administration.

Produced by The Ohio State University's Kirwan Institute for the Study of Race and Ethnicity, *Free To Ride* is a promising story about community action to correct an injustice.
