WHEREAS, Resolution No. 10400-20 authorized the City Manager to contract for right-of-way acquisition services for the projects listed below:

1. Kettering Traffic Signal Replacements – Phase 3, City Project No. 02-005D (ODOT Project MOT-Kettering Traffic Signal Replacements – Phase 3, PID 105950);
2. Hewitt Avenue Bikeway Connector, City Project No. 05-004H (ODOT Project MOT-Hewitt Bikeway Connector, PID 105751).

WHEREAS, unanticipated right-of-way acquisition and related services are needed; and

WHEREAS, the Hewitt Avenue Bikeway Connector is a joint project with the City of Centerville and the estimated costs will be split 50-50 with Centerville;

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO ALLOW THE CITY OF KETTERING TO SERVE AS RESPONSIBLE LEAD AGENCY FOR ADMINISTRATION OF THE WEST STROOP ROAD SIDEWALK – STONEBRIDGE ROAD TO RIDGEWAY ROAD PROJECT (CITY PROJECT NO. 05-213F; ODOT PROJECT MOT-W STROOP WALK PH. 2, PID 113340)**

WHEREAS, Section 5501.03(D) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation (“ODOT”) may coordinate the activities of the Department with other appropriate public authorities and enter into contracts with such authorities as necessary to carry out its duties, powers and functions; and

WHEREAS, the following listed project is a transportation activity eligible to receive federal/state funding:

- a. West Stroop Road Sidewalk – Stonebridge Road to Ridgeway Road Project (City Project No. 05-213F; ODOT Project MOT-W Stroop Walk Ph. 2, PID 113340).

WHEREAS, the City of Kettering has received funding approval for the project listed above from the program manager having responsibility for the federal/state funds involved; and

WHEREAS, it is the mutual desire of ODOT and the City of Kettering to have the City of Kettering serve as the responsible lead agency for administration of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into one or more agreements with ODOT to allow the City of Kettering to serve as the responsible lead agency for administration of the West Stroop Road Sidewalk – Stonebridge Road to Ridgeway Road Project (City Project No. 05-213F; ODOT Project MOT-W Stroop Walk Ph. 2, PID 113340).
