## **Vicki Scuri SiteWorks**

### **Corten Steel**

The City of Kettering replaced the Schantz Avenue Bridge and commissioned Vicki Scuri SiteWorks (Lake Forest Park, WA) to integrate artwork into the project site. Scuri designed the steel fencing and adjacent tower to be a visible gateway for those entering and leaving Kettering. The steel's decorative patterning was inspired by the historic trolleys that originally ran north to south along present-day Dixie Drive and the ornamentation of the historic cash registers manufactured nearby. Of the design, Scuri wrote, "The artwork promotes a more livable environment and celebrates Kettering and its residents."

*Schantz* was commissioned by the City of Kettering's CitySites Public Art Program and installed in 2020.
