

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE KETTERING MUNICIPAL COURT, TO ACCEPT A BODY ARMOR GRANT FROM THE OHIO ATTORNEY GENERAL

WHEREAS, the City, on behalf of the Kettering Municipal Court, applied for a body armor grant from the Ohio Attorney General, funded by the Ohio Bureau of Worker's Compensation, to enhance the safety and prevent injury of law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, said Grant funds will be used to purchase body armor for probation officers of the Kettering Municipal Court to wear while performing field work; and

WHEREAS, matching funds of 25% are required under this Grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant application has been approved;

TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP AND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL FILE OF THE CITY OF KETTERING TO SHOW THE INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS ON VARIOUS CITY STREETS IN THE CITY OF KETTERING, OHIO

Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Kettering, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Traffic Control Map and the Traffic Control file of the City of Kettering, Ohio are hereby amended to show:

A. <u>NO PARKING ANY TIME</u> – North side of W. Springhill Ave from a point 80 feet west of S. Dixie Drive to a point 235 feet west of S. Dixie Drive for a total distance of approximately 155 feet.

<u>Section 2.</u> The City Engineer is hereby directed to have signs erected or taken down in accordance with this amendment.

<u>Section 3.</u> As permitted in Section 406.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Kettering, Ohio, the temporary traffic control authorization has been used to quickly install these regulations.

<u>Section 4.</u> As provided in Section 4-8 of the City Charter, this Ordinance shall be effective two weeks after adoption.
