### Monday August 2, 2021

- 0925 hrs Several crews were dispatched to 2108 Reardon on a dead body. The caller had come over after **Tonia R. Davis W/F/43** had not shown up for work and found her deceased in the bedroom with her live in boyfriend, **Trent M. Koehler W/M/27** who was also deceased. Suspected drug paraphernalia was located in the area of the bodies. Detectives were contacted and responded for further investigation. **21-032554**
