POLICE BLOTTER

Monday August 23, 2021

- 2147 hrs Officers conducted a traffic stop in the 2700 block of S Dixie for a registration violation. Upon contacting the driver, it was learned the driver was under suspension. A consent search was conducted and suspected Fentanyl was located in the car. **Gregory A. Preston B/M/30 and Chevits W.
