CITY OF KETTERING CITY COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES DECEMBER 14, 2021

The Council of the City of Kettering, Ohio, met in a workshop session on Tuesday, December 14, 2021, in the Deeds Conference Room, Kettering Government Center, 3600 Shroyer Road. The meeting came to order at 6:51 p.m.
