Monday February 14, 2022

1944 hrs Officers responded to the Highland County jail to pick up a subject on an original KMC warrant. **Miquan Anderson b/m/27**, was arrested for Failure to Comply and transported to KPD jail, where he was also served citations. **21-050413**
