1. The applicant agrees to hold the City of Kettering and the City manager or his authorized agent harmless from all claims, damages, or proceedings of any kind, and from all responsibility for personal or property damages (public or private) caused directly or indirectly as a result of the transportation of said vehicle(s) or object(s).
2. All vehicles operating under a special permit shall be manned by two or more operators or drivers. The permit shall be in the possession of the driver at all times during the progress of transportation and will be shown on demand to any police officer or other authorized employee of the City of Kettering.
3. No vehicle(s) or object(s) being transported under special permit shall be left parked on the roadway either day or night except in the case of an emergency, in which case adequate protection shall be provided for the traveling public. The vehicle(s) shall not be loaded or unloaded within the traveled limits of the street or alley without special permission from the City Manager or his authorized agent.
4. Movements under special permits shall be made in such a manner as to impede the least possible extent the normal traffic. Flagman shall be furnished by the applicant to protect and direct traffic when necessary due to limited sight distance or other hazards.
5. In the case of non-compliance with the provisions of the permit, same shall immediately be considered void and the operator of the vehicle subject to arrest.
6. The operator of the vehicle must comply with all laws, ordinances, rules or regulations covering the movement of traffic over highways and streets.
7. The permission granted restricts the movement of the vehicle(s) or object(s) to the streets or alleys specified between the points designated, and within the time allotted.
8. In general no permit will be issued in excess of the limitations set forth in ORC. §5577.04

Nothing in this article is to be construed as making mandatory the granting of permits for loads complying with the above schedule when at the discretion of the City Manager or his authorized agent the route specified is considered incapable of withstanding the burden or too narrow to safely accommodate normal traffic in conjunction with proposed excess loads.
