POLICE BLOTTER

Monday March 14, 2022

- 1230 hrs Officers were dispatched to the area of 4313 Far Hills on a Welfare Check. They located **Daniel Minshall W/M/25** at the rear of this location unconscious in his vehicle. The male did wake when the door was opened and denied any drug use. A consent search of the vehicle located suspected drug paraphernalia. Minshall was issued a summons and released. **22-011838**
- 1822 hrs. Officers stopped a vehicle on Wilmington Pike near Patterson for a moving violation. The driver was identified as **Lisa M. Kidd (B/F/41)**. Ms. Kidd had an active warrant for DUS through OSP. She was arrested and taken to the Kettering Jail. **22-011887**
