### Monday June 6, 2022

- 1348hrs Officers stopped a vehicle on Hoyle near Dixie after running the vehicle through our system and using JusticeWeb to confirm the driver was DUS. The driver lied about his identity but eventually admitted to being **Michael Hamblin, w/m/47**, who was confirmed as DUS. Hamblin was arrested for falsification. Hamblin was found in possession of suspected methamphetamines once booked into the jail. Hamblin was charged falsification, drug possession, and failure to disclose personal information to avoid a citation, illegal conveyance, and obstructing official business. **22-025712**
