### Monday July 18, 2022

- 0930 hrs      Officers made a traffic stop in the area of Wilmington and Imperial. The driver, **Ian P. Cox W/M/32** was found to have an active warrant from Miami County SO for Probation Violation. When arrested, he was asked if there were any weapons in his vehicle and stated that there were not. An inventory search located a loaded handgun in the center console. Cox was issued a summons for Failure to Notify CCW. He was transported to jail without incident. **22-032650**
