Monday October 31, 2022

Multiple emptied bottles of whiskey were found in the vehicle along with a capsule containing suspected drugs. The male was identified as **Justin Davison, W/M/33**. He was charged with OVI and refused any tests. He was cited for OVI and released to KMH for further treatment. The suspected drugs will be sent to BCI for further analysis. **22-051162**
