2023 Bare Steel/Cast Iron Replacement Work

KETTERING, OHIO

Scope of work

CenterPoint Energy's multi-year pipeline replacement program is an investment in infrastructure to continue providing reliable natural gas service to our Ohio customers. In 2023 CenterPoint Energy will retire approximately **67 miles** of bare steel/cast iron (BSCI) pipeline in Ohio.

At the completion of the multi-year project CenterPoint Energy plans to replace more than **838 miles** of BSCI pipelines and retire about 150,000 service lines throughout its service territory in Ohio.

Gas mains under streets and sidewalks will be replaced first, followed by service lines running directly to homes and businesses. Upon completion of the work and dependent on weather, affected sidewalks, yards and streets will be restored.
