Winners will be selected in both Middle and High school categories and receive a \$50 gift card, and be invited to attend a City Council meeting for recognition.

TOPICS

- Who inspires you to work toward creating a better world and why?
- What can be done to fight racism and celebrate diversity?
- How have you been affected by or involved in the issue you choose to address?
