### PROGRAMS & CLASSES

#### **Glass Fusing-Intro Workshop (ages 16+)**

*June 20, July 11 or August 15, 6 – 8:30 p.m.*

Students learn how to cut and arrange glass to create a kiln-fused 2 piece set of matching dishes. This class can be taken as an introduction or as a skill refresher. \$10 – \$29 materials fee, depending on the student-selected project, due to instructor at first class.
