

Bucket Bay

- This area is designed for children under 10 years old
- Swim diapers are required for infants and non-toilet trained patrons
- Diapers changes must be done at the bathhouse
- Feet first only on stomach or back when using slides
- Use steps to access play structure; No climbing up slides
- No sitting on or climbing over dividing wall of Vortex Pool
- Please share the play equipment
- Running or rough play are not permitted



Clownfish Cove

- This area is designed for children under 6 years old
- Swim diapers are required for infants and non-toilet trained patrons
- Diapers changes must be done at the bathhouse
- Feet first only on stomach or back when using slides
- Feet first entry only into pool
- No running on deck or in pool
- Food or drink are permitted at picnic tables only



Liquid Fury

- Must be 48" to use slides
- Weight limit is 350 lbs per manufacturer specifications
- Stand respectfully in line; No pushing, shoving, line jumping or holding a place for someone
- One slider permitted at a time
- Wait until guard signals for you to go down then slide feet first, arms and legs crossed, sitting or laying on back
- Upon entry into plunge pool, swim directly to steps and exit
- Non-swimmers should not ride the slide
- Patrons must have proper swimwear to ride; Suits with rivets are not permitted
- No flotation devices, glasses, goggles, jewelry or hats are permitted



Tropical Twisters

- Must be 48" to use slides

 Note: Patrons under 48" tall may ride after passing swim test and wearing a wrist band
- Weight limit is 350 lbs per manufacturer specifications
- Stand respectfully in line; No pushing, shoving, line jumping or holding a place for someone
- No sitting or climbing on rocks
- One slider permitted at a time
- Wait until guard signals you to go down and then slide feet first, laying on back
- Upon entry into plunge pool, swim directly to steps and exit
- Non-swimmers should not ride the slide
- Patrons must have proper swimwear to ride; Suits with rivets are not permitted
- No flotation devices, glasses, goggles, jewelry or hats are permitted



Under Water Odyssey

- Open for use to all ages
- Swim diapers are required for infants and non-toilet trained patrons
- Diapers changes must be done at the bathhouse
- Children under 9 years old should be supervised
- No food or drink inside splash pad area
- Please share the play equipment
- Running or rough play are not permitted
- Avoid sitting or standing directly on top of or in line with a spraying water feature



Vortex Pool

- Water depth is 42 inches (3.5 feet)
- Enter pool at the stairs and do not hang on stairs or railings
- Keep stairs clear for swimmers to enter and exit pool
- Diving or jumping into pool is not permitted
- No sitting on or climbing over dividing wall of Bucket Bay
- Swim diapers are required for infants and non-toilet trained patrons



General Water Park Guidelines

- 1. Adventure Reef is a family-friendly facility; Appropriate language or attire is required
- 2. Adventure Reef is not responsible for lost or stolen items; Patrons are encouraged to use onsite lockers located in locker rooms to store personal items
- 3. All clothing and diaper changes must occur in the locker rooms located in the bathhouse
- 4. Waterpark closures may occur for inclement weather or unfavorable water conditions
- 5. Refunds are not given for inclement weather or any other reasons
- 6. To maintain the privacy of our patrons, camera images should be restricted to your family and friends; Camera usage is strictly prohibited in locker rooms
- 7. Children under 12 years old must be accompanied by an adult
- 8. Children under 7 years old and all patrons in a floatation device must be within an arm's length of an adult when in the water
- 9. Lounge chairs are for patrons 13 years old and up
- 10. All chairs must behind brick line on pool deck; Personal chairs are permitted to be brought inside the water park
- 11. Please dispose of all trash in proper receptacles
- 12. The following are prohibited at the water park:
 - Smoking or use of electronic cigarette devices
 - Glass containers, alcohol or controlled substances
- 13. No food or drinks in the water
- 14. Personal coolers are permitted and may be checked by Adventure Reef Staff
- 15. No running, rough play or inappropriate behavior is permitted in the water park
- 16. Flotation devices must be US Coast Guard approved
- 17. Traditional swimwear required (riveted shorts are not permitted on slides)
- 18. Registered Service Animals are permitted in the water park but not in the water
- 19. Individuals who are pregnant or have pre-existing health conditions should refrain from using water slides
- 20.15 minute rest breaks occur at 2pm, 3pm and 4pm; individuals with a disability or individuals 18 and older are permitted in the water at this time
- 21. The First Aid station is located next to the waterfall feature; this is also the hub for lost and missing children and adults
- 22. Pool lift is available for entry into water upon request
- 23. Shower before and after pool usage encouraged

Adventure Reef Water Park staff members are the final authority on all rules, discipline and ejection of patrons from the facility.
