Watch as your yard waste embarks on a journey to the Leaf Farm at 1801 Spaulding Road, where the magic happens!

Our dedicated Street Department team will grind and turn your debris into high-quality mulch, which will then be available for FREE to Kettering citizens at Indian Riffle Park, starting in April!

Not only will you get your hands on some fantastic sustainable mulch, but you'll also be contributing to the beautification of our city's parks. Over 500 yards of mulch are used yearly to enhance our green spaces!
