Ice Skating



The Kettering Ice Arena offers 8 months of ice each year. Our current season continues through mid-April 2017. The Kettering Ice Arena is a municipal facility dedicated to our citizens and to clubs and organizations in Kettering and surrounding areas. Our goal is to provide a wide range of recreational activities for all ages. We currently have organizations that provide hockey, figure skating and synchronized skating opportunities. We can accommodate the beginner through competitive skater with our lesson programs and various open-skate sessions.

Please note: There will be a 15-minute ice resurfacing at the beginning and middle of each skating session.

The following guidelines apply to all public skating sessions.

- Patrons will circle skate in one direction only.
- Cones will be placed in center ice to create a small space for freestyle and private lessons. (Please do not move cones and keep skate blades below knee level.)
- Private lessons conducted by a City of Kettering Instructor will have the rightof-way when an instructor is on the ice with a student.
- No freestyle or ice dancing will be permitted on the general ice surface.
- No sticks or pucks are permitted during any public or open skate.

Special Notes:

- Children 2 and younger are admitted free with a paid adult, but pay \$2 for skate rental (exception: Preschool Skate).
- Children 8 and younger must be accompanied by someone 13 or older.
- Readmission is charged for anyone leaving and re-entering the arena during a public skating session.
- A drop-in admission fee will be charged for students taking private lessons during a public skating session.
- ** Skate sharpening services may not be immediately available during an open skate due to long admission lines.

GROUP RATES AT THE ICE ARENA

Group Rates During Public Skate Hours Small Group Discounts

Groups of 10 to 12 children/adults are eligible for a group rate during all scheduled public skates. Adults must accompany the children—one adult to every five to ten children.

All adults accompanying youth must validate residency to receive a resident group rate. You are invited to enter the Ice Arena and speak to the cashier to verify the group rate and to pay for the participants (skate rental and admission).

Large Group Discounts

Should your Group contain 13 or more adults/children, please come to the Kettering Recreation Complex Front Desk to purchase a Group Coupon. Adults must accompany the children—one adult to every five to 10 children. Skate rental will be paid for separately in the Ice Arena.

The group representative may validate residency for the entire group to receive a resident group rate.

PUBLIC SKATES AT THE ICE BOX

Adult Skate

Whether you are an adult who loves to skate but dislikes the large crowds of an open skate or just someone who always wanted to learn to skate, this session is set aside just for you. All skill levels enjoy the opportunity for exercise and friendship at our adult skate from 8 to 10 a.m. each Monday, Wednesday and Friday. You must be 18 or older; regular admission rates apply. Proper I.D. must be shown to receive resident rates. For your own safety, please refrain from using headphones on the ice. Participating in this skate does not guarantee use of the entire ice surface.

Stick Time

This time is set aside Tuesday afternoons from 2 to 3:50 p.m. and Wednesday and Friday mornings from 10 to 11 a.m. for patrons of all ages to come and practice their stick handling skills. Helmet required, sticks and pucks not provided. Admission rates: \$3 for Kettering residents, \$6 for non-residents and two-hour stick time is \$5 for Kettering residents, \$10 for non-residents.

Public Open Skate

Please join us for exciting fall open skates for all ages. Skate sizes that we rent range from preschool (sizes 6 to 13) to youth/adult (sizes 1 to 14). We do have hockey skates for rent. Please be prepared to provide an I.D. in exchange for hockey skates. Participating in this skate does not guarantee use of the entire ice surface.

Mixed Freestyle

This session is for patrons level Basic 3 and above. Instruction is not included while on the ice. Hockey Power Skating practice and lessons are permitted in this session; no sticks or pucks allowed. Programs may be played in order received. Maximum number of skaters is 26. Admission Rates: \$5/resident; \$10/non-resident. Mixed Freestyle 5-visit Punch Card Rates: \$25/resident; \$50/non-resident. Passes may not be applied to this session.

Please remember that participating in any public skating session does not guarantee use of the entire ice surface. Management reserves the right to choose the appropriate radio station based on type of session.

YOUTH & HOME SCHOOL PUBLIC SKATE

Ages Toddler – 15 (12 and under must be accompanied by adult 18 or older)

The Kettering Ice Arena has reserved a special time for parents and their youth; Home School students are welcome! What a great time to bring your children to the rink! The crowds are much smaller, providing an excellent opportunity for fun and exercise for both you and your child. An adult may bring three children. Cones are provided to help children skate (this is the only drop-in session that implements are permitted). Proper ID must be shown to receive resident rates.
