1. What kind of study is being conducted at the Ice Arena?

Kettering Ice Arena Program and Facility Study

A process to study the Kettering Ice Arena facility is underway. This project is the next phase in the study of this space following the 2014 completion of a Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing Systems Analysis which estimated the facility requires \$6 to 7 million in upgrades.

2. What is the timeline for this study?

MSA Architects of Cincinnati is the lead consultant and is evaluating all proposed renovation designs for the Ice Arena. Ballard*King & Associates Ltd., a consulting firm specializing in recreation facility operations and programming, will conduct the management and operation review.
