

## **Adventure Reef Water Park Rules**

- 1. Please shower before entering the water.
- 2. Walk please! No running.
- 3. All patrons under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult (age 18+).
- 4. All patrons 6 and under-OR-in a flotation device must swim within arm's length of an adult (age 18+).
- 5. The following are **NOT permitted** in the water park:
  - Glass Containers
  - Vaping Devices
  - Tobacco Usage
  - Alcohol
  - Non-Swim Diapers (in water)
  - Air-inflated Flotation Devices and Toys
- 6. Small coolers are permitted and may be checked by staff.
- 7. While in the water **NO:** 
  - Spitting
  - Blowing Your Nose
  - Urinating
  - Defecating
- 8. Do not hang on ropes, nets, dividers, or lane lines in any area.
- 9. During Rest Periods **only** the following groups are allowed in the water:
  - Adults (age 18+)
  - Children ages 3 & under accompanied by an adult (age 18+)
  - Children with disabilities accompanied by an adult (age 18+)
  - Individuals with disabilities
- 10. Swim diapers **must** be worn by infants, children, and individuals that are not toilet trained.
- 11. Patrons of all ages, including infants and children, **must** change in the locker rooms (this includes diaper changes; please do not remove dirty diapers on the pool decks, patios, or grassy areas).
- 12. All patrons 14 and under who want to enter the deep end in the indoor pool are subject to a swim test if the lifeguard deems it necessary.
- 13. No flotation devices, goggles, or jewelry on the slides or diving board.
- 14. Slides and diving board have a 350 lbs. MAX weight limit per manufacturer rules.
- 15. Service animals are permitted in the pool area, but **not** in the water (only animals recognized as service animals are permitted).
- 16. Obey the Lifeguard **AT ALL TIMES**—they have the authority over the pool!

The First Aid Station, located next to the waterfall, is our hub for all lost and missing parents and children. If you are lost or have lost someone, please speak to the lifeguard or water park attendant at the First Aid Station.
