PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES CAREFULLY!

Create a poster that reflects your understanding of the important role that trees play in the world. Before creating poster, take time to think about the variety of ways trees benefit your community and your life. Make sure your poster follows the contest rules by using the checklist below.

- 1. All entries must be original artwork created by a student who is currently in grades 6–12 in the City of Kettering. Only ONE entry per student.
- 2. Entries may be created with marker, crayon, paint pens, watercolor, ink, acrylic, colored pencil, and/or tempera paint. Digital media accepted (printed hard copy must be submitted).
 - No other media will be accepted.
 - Entries should not display the names of commercial products, companies, or organizations.
- 3. Entries must be no smaller than 8.5" x 11" and no larger than 14" x 18."
- 4. Entries must be suitable for duplication, display, and framing (nothing 3-dimensional).
- 5. The poster must incorporate the contest theme in some way. The theme Plant *Trees...Plant Hope!* MUST appear on the poster. All words must be spelled correctly.
- 6. Entries should not be matted, mounted, laminated, framed, wrinkled or folded.
- 7. By entering your artwork, you are agreeing to allow duplication and display of it on all of our media resources and within our facilities.
- 8. Submitted artwork may be collected May 2 6, 2022. Location to be determined.
- 9. Winning tips: Use color, cover the poster (no white spaces), make lettering clean and neat, be creative!
- 10. Drop your artwork off at Rosewood Art Center (2655 Olson Drive/937-296-0294) or the Habitat Environmental Center (3036 Bellflower Street/937-296-2477) by 4 p.m. on January 10, 2022.
